- Be open and receptive to ideas.
- Liaise and act as a representative of pre-identified organization/community/business or stakeholder group by providing feedback to the project team and formally communicating relevant information back to their respective groups.





Woodbine Ave. to Coxwell Ave: Culvert Installation at Small's Creek (Williamson Park Ravine North)

- Installation of the new culvert is complete
- Next steps:
 - Creation of new riverbed
 - Diversion of creek
- Piling for temporary shoring in preparation for construction of Retaining Wall 4 (RW4)
- Daytime working



Coxwell Ave. to Greenwood Ave.

- Installation of permanent lagging and coping at Retaining Wall 6 is complete
- Hydroseeding underway
- Removal of Unity Road ramp will follow completion of hydroseeding
- Duration: Approx. 8 Months
- Day and night time working



Greenwood Ave. to Jones Ave.

- Backfilling and coping for Retaining Wall 7 underway
- Hydroseeding to follow
- Duration: ~ 4 Months
- Day and night time working



Jones Ave. to Pape Ave.

- Work crews will continue to use Pape Ave. for access to the rail corridor
- Duration: ~ 12 months
- Day and night time working
