- Adhere to all aspects of the Terms of Reference and Code of Conduct.


#### Community Representatives or Area Residents and Businesses will:



# Woodbine Ave. to Coxwell Ave: Culvert Installation at Small's Creek (Williamson Park Ravine North)

### Diversion of Small's Creek:

- New culvert complete
- Diversion of creek into new culvert (new riverbed, minor earthmoving)

### Construction of Retaining Wall 4

- Drill pad installation underway
- Piling for temporary shoring in preparation for construction of Retaining Wall 4 (RW4) – early November
- Earth-moving equipment, piling rig, earth-compaction equipment
- Mainly daytime working



## **Coxwell Ave. to Greenwood Ave.**

- Hydroseeding underway
- Duration: Approx. 6 Months
- Day and nighttime working



### **Greenwood Ave. to Jones Ave.**

- Backfilling and coping for Retaining Wall 7 underway
- Hydroseeding to follow
- Duration: ~ 2 Months
- Day and nighttime working



## Jones Ave. to Pape Ave.

- Work crews will continue to use Pape Ave. for access to the rail corridor
- Duration: ~ 12 months
- Day and night time working
