Land Acknowledgment

The committee is designed to enable regular access to construction-related information, including schedule and timing information for local business owners, community groups and residents, through CLC representatives and discussions.

The Lakeshore East-West Team will:

- Provide accurate, understandable and timely information.
- Be open to feedback, give careful consideration to ideas, and report back to the larger project team.
- Adhere to all aspects of the Terms of Reference and Code of Conduct.

Community Representatives or Area Residents and Businesses will:

- Participate actively in regular meetings.
- Be open and receptive to ideas.
- Liaise and act as a representative of pre-identified organization/community/business or stakeholder group by providing feedback to the project team and formally communicating relevant information back to their respective groups.
- Adhere to all aspects of the Terms of Reference and Code of Conduct.

Woodbine Ave. to Coxwell Ave: Culvert Installation at Williamson Park Ravine North (Small's Creek)

Diversion of Small's Creek:

- Culvert headwall complete
- Diversion of creek into new culvert (new riverbed, minor earthmoving)


Construction of Retaining Wall 4

- Drill pad complete
- Piling for temporary shoring has started in preparation for construction of Retaining Wall 4 (RW4)
- Mainly daytime working




Coxwell Ave. to Greenwood Ave.

- Hydroseeding complete
- RW6 coping and permanent lagging complete
- Final fence installation ongoing




Greenwood Ave. to Jones Ave.

- Retaining wall complete
- Final fence installation ongoing
- Grounding and bonding ongoing



Jones Ave. to Pape Ave.

- Work crews will continue to use Pape Ave. for access to the rail corridor
- Duration: ~ 12 months
- Day and nighttime working
