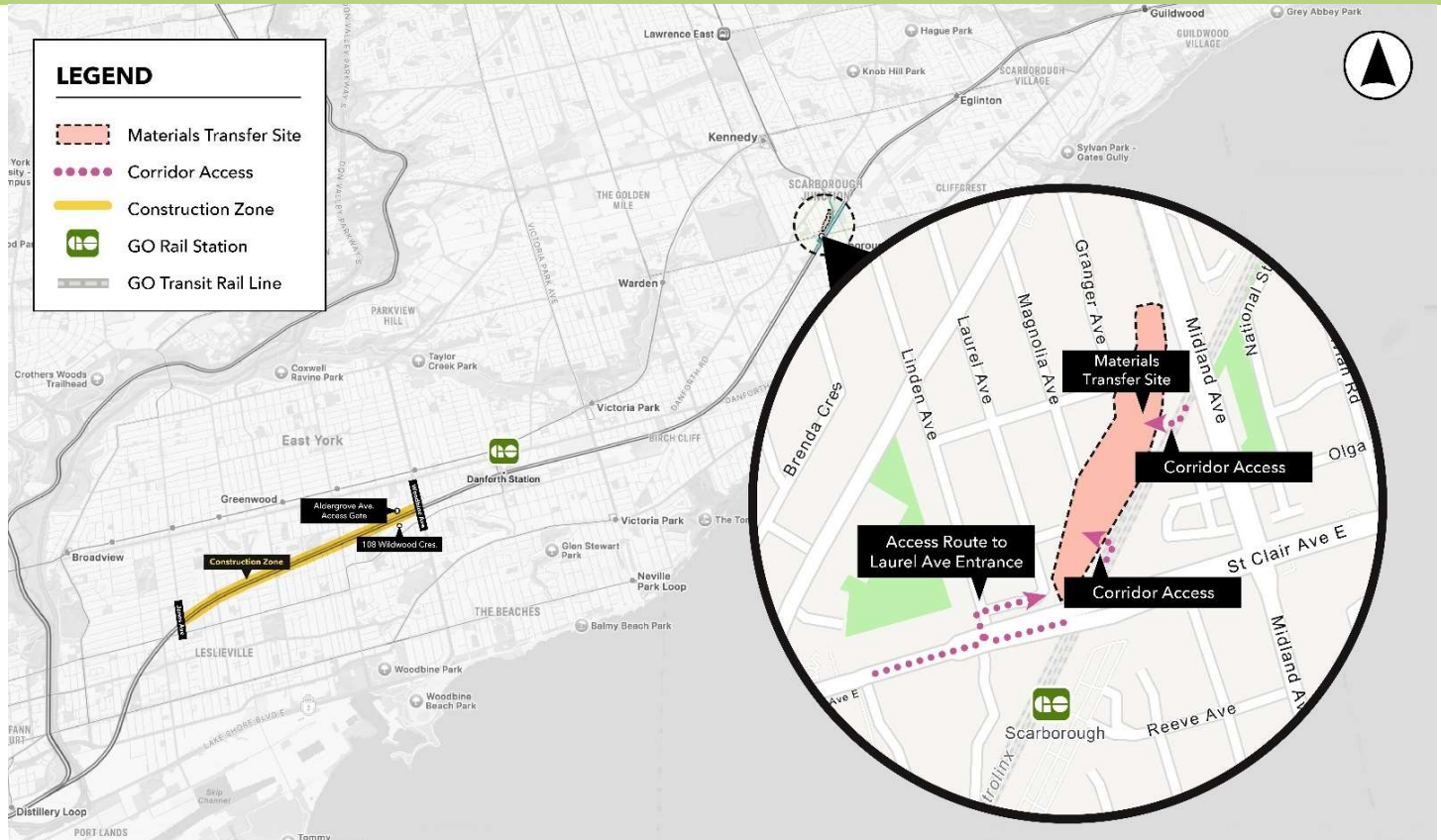


Supporting Track Construction within the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Daytime Material Deliveries from 3620 St. Clair Avenue East via the Stouffville Rail Corridor

Phase 1: September 1 to September 12, 2025

Phase 2: October 13 to October 24, 2025

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. These upgrades and improved service levels are designed to give you more options for getting where you need to go with fewer delays, more travel flexibility and less time spent waiting at the station.

What is happening?

As part of the GO Expansion project, we will be constructing approximately two kilometres of new siding track within the Lakeshore East rail corridor between Jones Avenue and Woodbine Avenue. To support construction, the GO Transit track maintenance site at 3620 St. Clair Avenue East will be used as a temporary materials transfer site. This new track will support GO Expansion construction by allowing work trains to move construction materials safely overnight while GO trains are not in service. After construction is completed, the siding track will become operational, as required, to support future infrastructure upgrades.

A second phase of activities will begin on October 13, 2025, also during daytime hours for approximately 2 weeks.	<p>We are building approximately two kilometres of new storage track adjacent to the main line of the Lakeshore East rail corridor for storing work trains.</p> <p>Activities at 3620 St. Clair Ave. E. may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Daytime receiving of materials by truck. • Daytime rail deliveries as required. • Other activities as required.

HOURS OF WORK

- Material delivery, loading and transferring will take place Monday to Friday during daytime hours (8 a.m. to 8 p.m.) beginning on September 1, 2025, for approximately 2 weeks.
- To complete this track work project, a second phase of activities will follow beginning October 13, 2025, for approximately 2 weeks.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will use the GO Transit track maintenance site at 3620 St. Clair Ave. E. as a temporary materials handling and transfer site to support Danforth siding track construction.
- Residents can expect noise, vibration, dust near the work areas.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and communities, including:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - White noise backup alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
 - Noise and vibration monitoring as required.
 - Minimal use of residential roads as access routes.

- Not parking or idling vehicles on residential streets.
- Installing temporary noise-absorbent panels on fencing within the site, to manage and mitigate noise.
- Work will take place within the rail corridor and on Metrolinx property.
- Please note that the scope of work is subject to adjustments as the project progresses.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience as we complete this critical work.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS

- There may be temporary periods of increased truck traffic on designated access routes and near the site at 3620 St. Clair Avenue East.
- There are no anticipated impacts to pedestrians, traffic or transit (see map).
