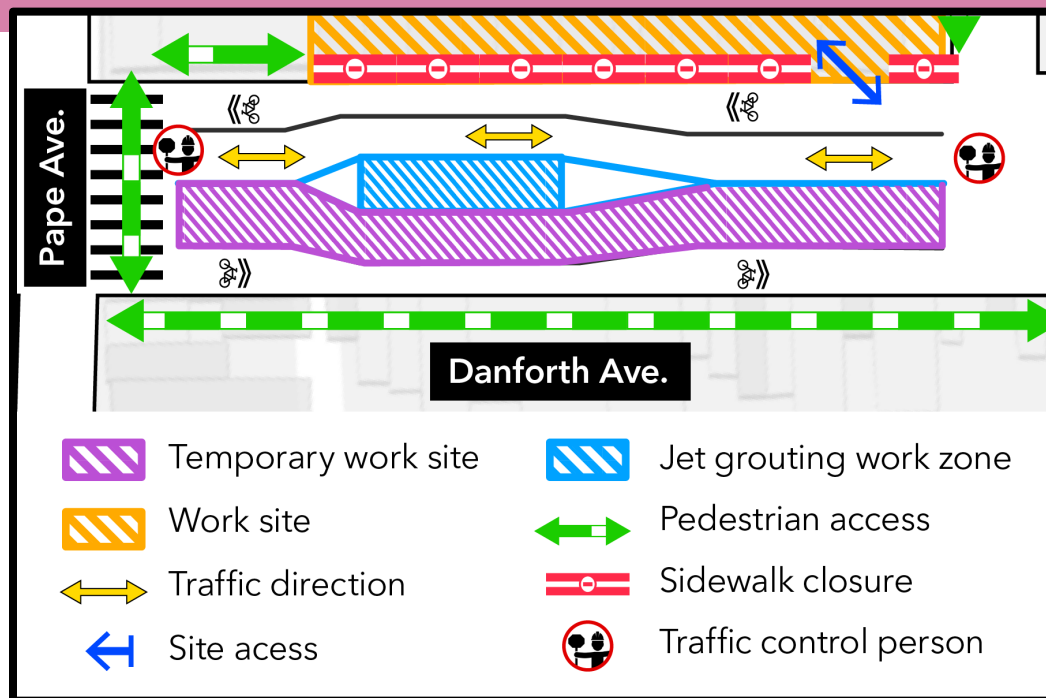


Overnight monitoring installation on Danforth Ave

Dates and duration: Wednesday, August 6 (evening) to Friday, August 8 (morning)

Hours of work: 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.



What is Happening?

- On Wednesday, August 6th, and Thursday, August 7th, 2025, Utility monitoring instruments will be installed in the eastbound lane on Danforth Avenue to support jet grouting works.
- Jet grouting is a soil stabilization technique that involves injecting grout into the earth below the surface. It is required to add stability underneath existing structures near where excavation work will occur.
- The monitoring instruments will trigger alerts in the event of excess vibration or settlement so adjustments can be made to prevent any issues.
- The eastbound traffic lane on Danforth Ave, between Pape Ave and Eaton Ave, will be closed to complete this work safely.
- Bi-directional traffic will be facilitated via the westbound lane by traffic control personnel. Please review "What to Expect" below for specific details.

What to Expect

- Construction equipment will access the site from Danforth Avenue.
- Noise from construction equipment including a hydro-vacuum truck, hand coring equipment, and trucks can be expected.
- A paid-duty officer will be stationed at the Pape-Danforth intersection to support.

- Traffic control personnel will alternate eastbound and westbound traffic flow through the westbound lane.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to delineate work zones.
- This work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 40 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
