
Trench installation under Pape Station secondary entrance walkway

Expected start date: As early as Thursday, August 14, 2025

Expected duration: Approximately two days

Hours of work: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- As early as late Thursday, August 14, 2025, crews will begin installing a trench that will go across the pedestrian access to the Lipton Avenue entrance of Pape Station, near Eaton Avenue.
- Work will take place between 7.a.m 7 p.m. for approximately two days.
- Work will occur in two stages to maintain pedestrian access.
- Installing the trench will improve the connection for supplying cement from the south to north side of the site, making operations more efficient.

What to expect

- One day will be allocated to excavate the trench, while the second day will be to restore the pathway
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to delineate work zones.
- There will be no impacts to TTC bus or subway service from this work.
- Work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be provided at all times.

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 40 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
