

Overnight Grade Crossing Enhancements and Temporary Lane Closures near the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor

August 28, 2025 to Early September 2025

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As part of grade crossing enhancements for the GO Expansion project, crews will be painting yellow high-visibility boxes onto the pavement near the Lakeshore West rail corridor grade crossings at Chartwell Rd., Kerr St. and Fourth Line, to enhance road safety. This work will require temporary partial lane closures to ensure a safe working environment and will take place overnight when GO trains are not in service.

Grade Crossing Enhancements	Chartwell Rd: Aug 28, 29 Kerr St: Sep 1, 2, 3 Fourth Line: Sep 4, 5	Monday-Friday: 10pm-5am (overnight)	To enhance roadway safety, crews will be painting yellow high-visibility boxes onto the pavement near grade crossings. This work will require temporary and partial lane closures within 50 metres of the tracks for 2-3 nights at each location.

HOURS OF WORK

- Painting is scheduled to take place Monday to Friday beginning August 28, 2025, between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., and will move within the areas highlighted on the map for 2-3 nights at each location.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will be painting yellow high-visibility boxes onto the pavement near the grade crossings to enhance safety.
- Residents nearby can expect some overnight noise, and site lighting near the rail corridor.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows.
 - The work area will be safely secured.
 - White noise backup alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
- Work may take place within and outside of the rail corridor.
- Work taking place outside of Metrolinx property will have the required permits and approvals from municipal or regional authorities.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS

- Temporary lane adjustments are required to complete this work safely.
- Traffic control persons will direct motorists safely around active work areas.
- One lane and sidewalk will remain open to motorists and pedestrians at all times.
- Work areas will be set up with clear signage and delineation.
- There are no anticipated impacts to public transit.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.
