Haul route paving inside the future Exhibition station site


Expected start date: As early as, end of August 2025

What is happening?

Construction is ongoing to deliver the Ontario Line at Exhibition. To enhance safety, durability, and further reduce dust leaving the site, crews will be paving the haul route within the site from Dufferin Street to the east end of the site at Strachan Avenue, as indicated in the map above.

Crews will not be working overnight every single day, depending on the activities on site during the day, scheduling and concrete deliveries, these will all impact the time when haul route paving will take place.

Crews will continue to work on key elements of the project, including foundations for a new station entrance, platform works, the Ontario Line tunnel portal, tunnel boring machine support structures and a traction power substation in the area. These activities will proceed during regular hours as outlined in previous notices.

What to expect

- Neighbours will hear and see several types of construction equipment in use during this phase, including concrete trucks, rollers and asphalt pavers to name a few. Other equipment will be in use as required and may be added or removed from the site throughout the duration of work.
- Mitigations are in place to limit the impact of debris and dirt to city streets.
- Crews may arrive on site earlier than 5:00 a.m. to prepare machinery and equipment.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
