

# Aurora GO: Major Track Closure

Friday, September 5, 2025 – Monday, September 8, 2025

From 8:00 p.m. on September 5 until 5:00 a.m. on September 8

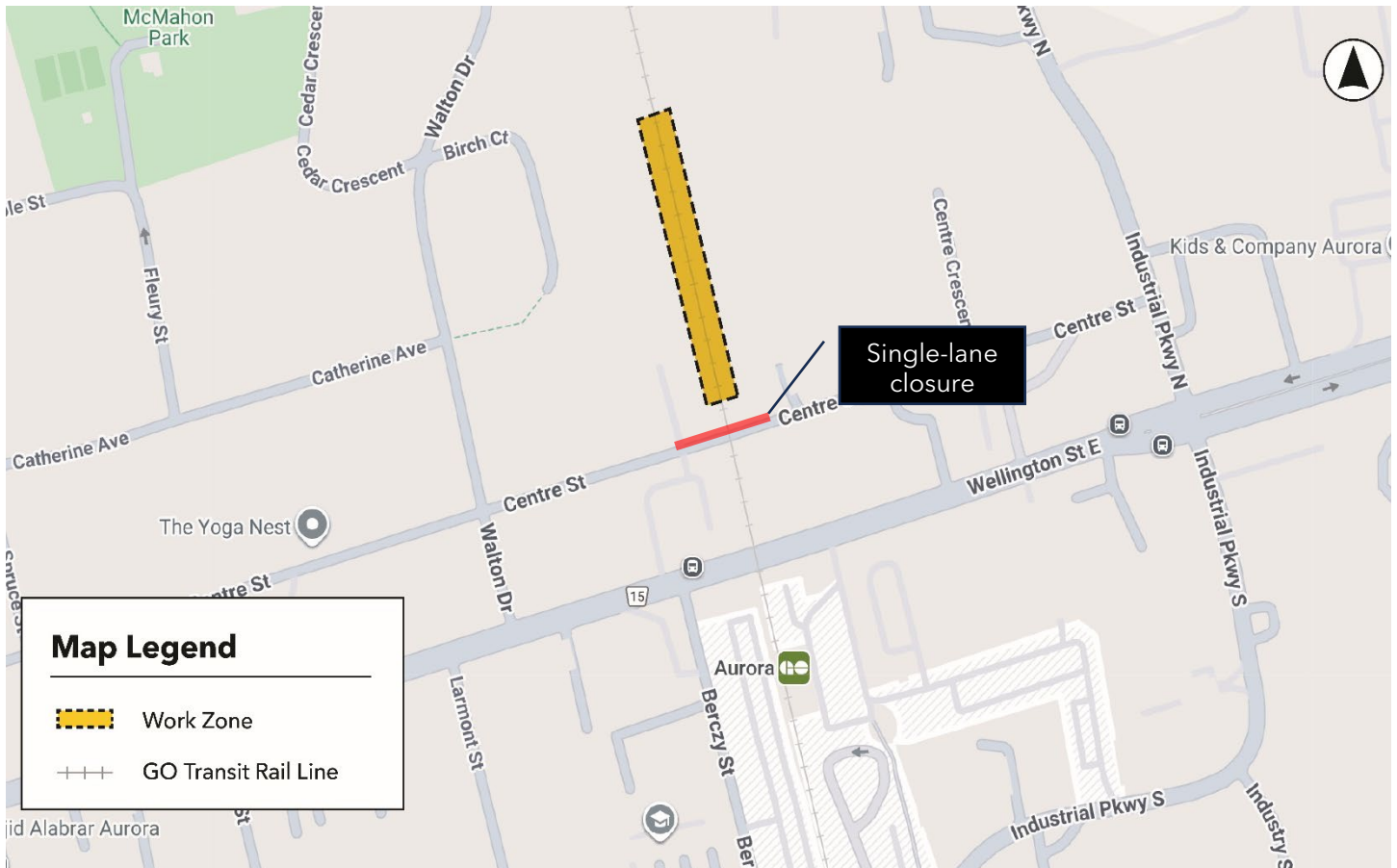


Figure 1: Approximate area of work zone. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

## What Is Happening

To support station improvements at Aurora GO, Metrolinx contractor **Grascan Construction Ltd.** will be conducting track rehabilitation works north of the station to remove existing rail ties, ballast, sub-ballast and sub-grade, and then will reinstall new materials to replace those that are removed.

This work will occur during continuous overnight and daytime hours from Friday, September 5 8:00 p.m., to Monday, September 8, at 5:00 a.m. We understand that overnight work is not ideal and will make every effort to mitigate impacts to the surrounding community during this important work. A single-lane closure will also be in place on Centre Street during this work.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- Metrolinx will be removing and reinstalling materials on the track (see Figure 1).
- Equipment to be used include various trucks, welding tools, and a crane.
- Property owners may experience some noise associated with construction activities and equipment. No significant noise levels are expected to be reached.
- Sound monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure that noise levels do not exceed a 65-decibel limit in compliance with Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work.
- Vibration monitors will also be in place as needed, depending on the work activities.

## HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur during continuous overnight and daytime hours between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

## LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will take place north of Centre Street within the rail corridor (see Figure 1).

## PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There will be a sidewalk along Centre Street adjacent to the lane closure.
- Flaggers will be in place to guide pedestrians past the work site.

## TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be a single-lane closure along Centre Street for the duration of this work in order to maintain an access point to the work site for the transport of equipment and materials.
- A traffic management plan will be in place to manage the flow of drivers and maintain traffic in both directions.

## TRANSIT IMPACTS

- During this Major Track Closure, service along the Barrie line will be paused.
