

# King City GO: Culvert Replacements

Friday, September 5 at 11:59 p.m. – Monday, September 8 at 5:00 a.m.




Figure 1: Approximate area of work zone. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

## What Is Happening

To support rail corridor enhancements at and around King City GO Station, Metrolinx crews will be replacing culverts at two points within the Barrie line rail corridor (see Figure 1 above). These culverts are necessary to allow water to flow beneath the rail tracks, and to maintain the ground around the tracks by preventing flooding or erosion. In order to safely complete this work, it will be done day and night starting on Friday, September 5 at 11:59 p.m. and finishing by the morning of Monday, September 8 at 5:00 a.m. during a Major Track Closure (MTC), which is a weekend pause of service along the Barrie line.

We understand that overnight work is not ideal. Metrolinx will implement mitigations wherever possible to reduce the impact of the activities on residents in the area. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to bring better and faster service to the Barrie line.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- This work is necessary to ensure that water does not flood or erode the ground around or below the rail line.
- Equipment to be used include an excavator, crawl dozers, and drum rollers.
- Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with these activities.
- Sound and air monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure that noise levels do not exceed a 65-decibel limit in compliance with Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work.
- Vibration monitors will be used to ensure vibration remains below acceptable levels.
- Lights will be pointed towards the track to minimize any light pollution to the area.

## HOURS OF WORK

- Work will commence at 11:59 p.m. on Friday, September 5 and be completed by 5:00 a.m. on Monday, September 8.

## LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur within the Barrie rail corridor at two points along the rail line:

- West of Keele Street and east of Hogan Court.
- North of Tatton Court.

## PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There will be no pedestrian impacts.

## TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be no traffic impacts.

## TRANSIT IMPACTS

- This work will occur over a weekend service pause of the entire Barrie rail line.
- Regular service will resume on Monday, September 8, 2025.
