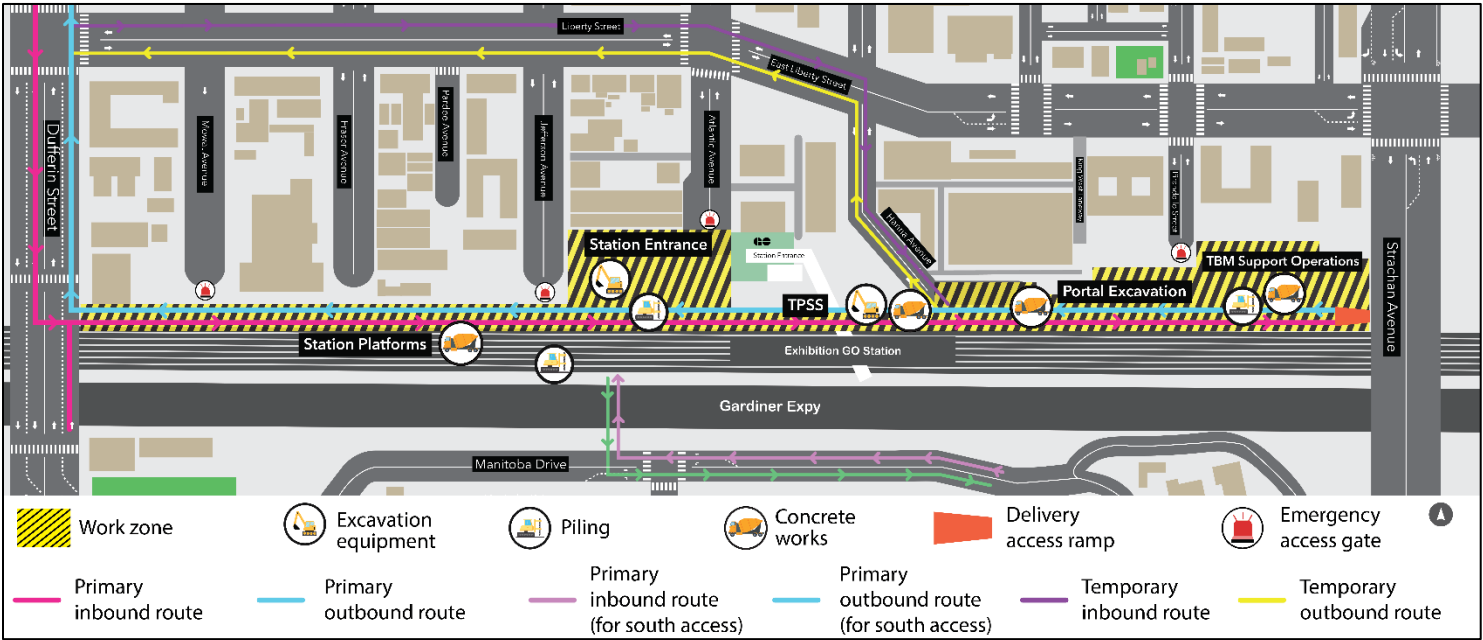


Exhibition portal concrete pour and delivery

Expected start date: As early as August 25, 2025
Expected duration: Up to once a week until November 2025
Hours of work: 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

What is happening?

Construction remains ongoing to deliver the Ontario Line at Exhibition. Through fall and winter 2025, crews will continue to construct various projects at the site, including station platforms, foundations for a new station entrance, the Ontario Line portal and a traction power substation to the area.

The tunnel launch portal continues to be constructed at the east end of the Ontario Line work site. Foundation and structural support, concrete works, waterproofing and rebar installations are required for this phase of work. To complete the concrete foundation, crews, concrete trucks and pumps are required to be on site as early as 5:00 a.m., this is required up to once a week until the end of November 2025. The exact dates of the concrete pours cannot be shared, as they are subject to change due to weather conditions and scheduling adjustments.

What to expect

- Neighbours will hear and see several types of construction equipment in use during this phase, including concrete trucks and concrete pumps, to name a few. Other equipment will be in use as required and may be added or removed from the site throughout the duration of work.
- Residents will see an increase in trucks during the concrete pours.
- Mitigations are in place to limit the impact of debris and dirt to city streets.
- Crews may arrive on site earlier than 5:00 a.m. to prepare machinery and equipment.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
