What is happening

We're seeing a high number of people illegally crossing the tracks at Markham GO Station to access nearby pathways, the parking lot, Station Plaza, or the opposite platform. At Metrolinx, safety is our top priority. Every journey matters—not just the destination, but how you get there. That's why we're reminding everyone of the real dangers of crossing train tracks in undesignated areas. Whether you're heading to work, meeting friends, or returning home, please take the extra few moments to use safe, designated paths.

Safety Considerations

- **Don't Cross Station Tracks** crossing tracks illegally can result in serious or fatal injury.
- Stand Behind the Yellow Line staying well behind the yellow line keeps you at a safe distance from oncoming or departing trains.
- Stay Alert trains may pass at any time. Stay alert and be aware of your surroundings as you travel through stations and platforms.



Safe Ways to Access Markham GO Station and the Surrounding Area

- 1. Use pedestrian traffic crossings to ensure safe access to get to the station.
- 2. Follow station signage that help guide pedestrians to safe access points.
- 3. Enter through the Main Station entrances and follow pedestrian pathways such as sidewalks to get to either platform. Available on both platforms are **PRESTO** devices and notice boards.
- 4. Plan your trip by signing up with **On the GO Alerts** so you are less likely to rush to the station. Unsure how to get around safely? Ask a station ambassador for safe access points. At Markham GO, your friendly and helpful station ambassador is available during weekday peak hours, Monday to Friday from 5:40 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
