Tree Pruning East Side of Pape Avenue


Expected start: September 4, 2025 **Expected duration:** Two (2) days **Hours of Work:** 7 am - 7 pm

What is happening?

- As early as, Thursday, September 4, crews will be pruning nine (9) trees on the east side of Pape Avenue, near the Pape - Langley intersection.
- Work will include pruning of the canopy and roots within reduced Tree Protection Zones (TPZ).

What to expect

 Short-term traffic interruptions can be expected while trucks and equipment enter and exit work zones; traffic control personnel will be present to direct vehicles and pedestrians.



- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to outline work zones.
- Work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
