Closure of southbound bus stop on McCowan Road at Meldazy Drive (North)

Start date/Duration: September 10, 2025 through November 2025

Note: Dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.





What is happening?

- Crews are continuing jet grouting work on McCowan Road, south of Brimorton Road.
- Jet grouting involves injecting and mixing cement-based grout into the ground to create a stronger, more stable soil structure. This process will help prevent ground movement and reduce water infiltration during tunnelling.
- This site will be similar to the jet grouting site already in place on McCowan Road just north of Brimorton Drive.

Bus stop closure

- The southbound TTC bus stop on McCowan Road at Meldazy Drive (North) will be temporarily closed as shown on the map.
- Alternate bus stops for this location are located at McCowan Road at Brimorton Drive and McCowan Road at Meldazy Drive (South).

What to expect?

- Expect noise from on-site construction equipment, including jet grout pumps, cement silos, front-end loaders, trucks and other machinery.
- Traffic barrels, fencing and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- To ensure pedestrian and driver safety, construction crews will occasionally temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks along McCowan Road. Signage will alert drivers and pedestrians to these temporary closures and detours.
- Please take care when travelling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing pedestrians. Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained to ensure pedestrian safety.

About the project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
