


Utilities Investigations on Church Street, Queen Street East

Expected start date: As early as September 14, 2025

Expected duration: One overnight shift (completed September 15, 2025)

Expected hours of work: 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

What is happening

- To support ongoing construction of the new Ontario Line subway crews will be investigating utilities on Church Street and Queen Street East, between Church Street and Ontario Street.
- These investigations are required to locate utilities and other underground infrastructure, in advance of future construction supporting the Ontario Line.
- The investigations will be completed from multiple locations as indicated in the map above; crews will move from work zone to work zone over the duration of one overnight shift.

What to expect

- Crews will use a CCTV camera to investigate utilities and other underground infrastructure, using existing access from manholes in the street.
- Intermittent closures are required to complete this work; crews will move from work zone to work zone over the course of one overnight shift.
- Traffic control personnel and paid duty officers will assist with safety detouring traffic during this work, as required.
- Minimal impact is expected from this work. Area residents and businesses may see lights or hear trucks set up to complete this work. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Work may be postponed, extended or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line
