
Exhibition utility relocation

Expected Start Date: As early as September 22, 2025

Expected Duration: Up to two weeks

Hours of Work: 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday

What is happening?

To accommodate the future Ontario Line subway and expanded Exhibition Station, crews will relocate underground utilities and install a manhole within the future Exhibition station site.

This phase of work will take place during daytime working hours within the construction site on the west side of Jefferson Avenue.

What to expect

 During this phase of construction, crews will use trucks and trailers to deliver equipment or remove materials, as well as excavators and other demolition equipment to relocate underground utilities and install a manhole. A hydrovac machine may be used when required.



- Residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from equipment working between the Gardiner Expressway, the rail corridor, and the Ontario Line work zone.
- Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday.
- There is no expected impact on GO Transit operations or service.
- Work may be postponed or re-scheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
