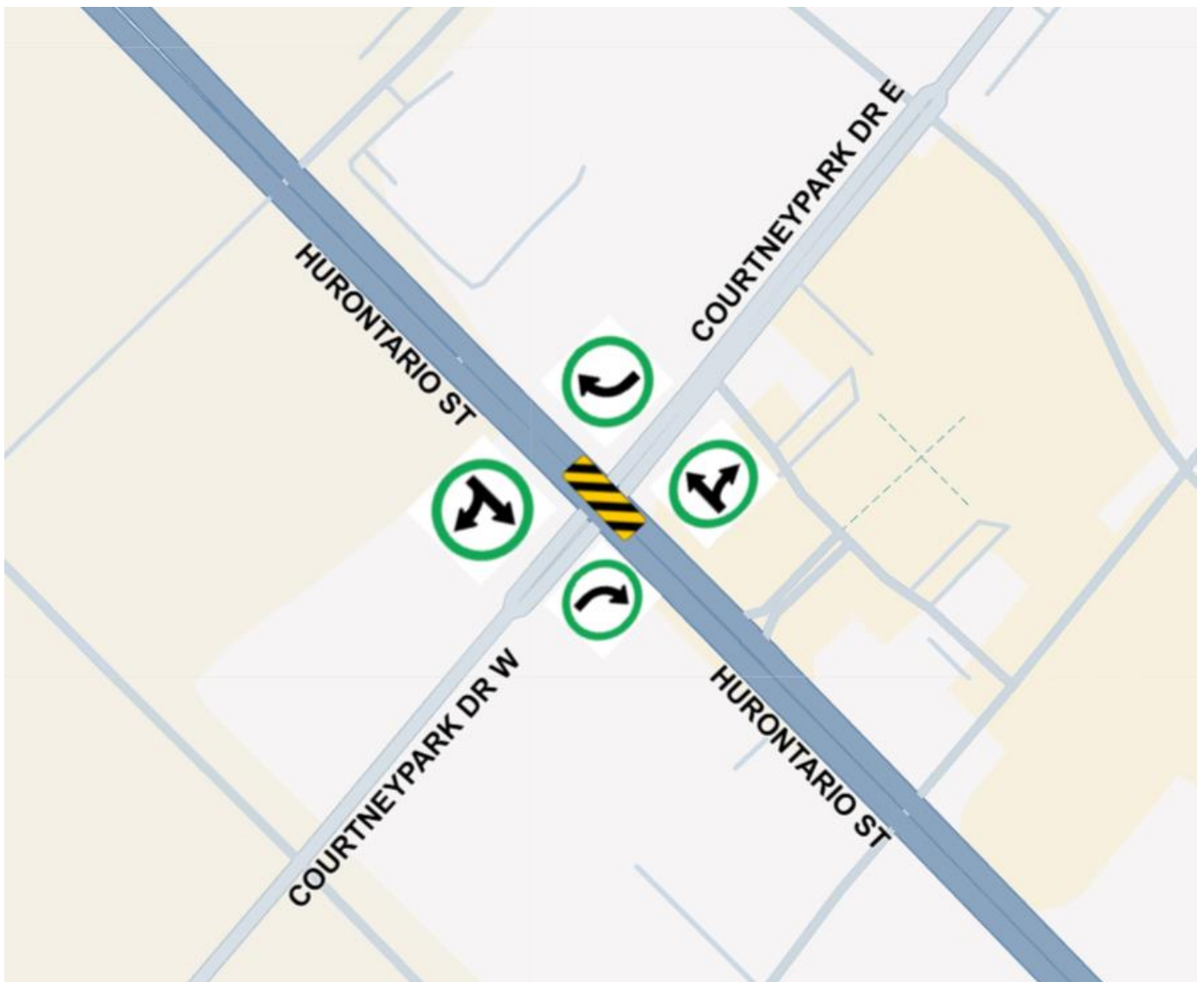


# UPDATE: Track Work at Courtneypark Drive and Hurontario Street

September 22, 2025, to November 4, 2025



## What work is taking place?

Necessary track rework at the intersection of Courtneypark Drive and Hurontario Street, will begin on **Monday September 22, 2025, at 10 p.m.**, until **November 4, 2025, at 10 p.m.** This track rework is being done to ensure safe operations of the future light rail vehicles.

This work requires east-west intersection closures and left-turn restrictions at the intersections of Courtneypark Drive and Hurontario Street. Crews will be performing track rework including track installation and concrete pouring.

Construction work at this intersection is scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Courtneypark Drive will not be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. ### TIMING

- Work at Courtneypark Drive and Hurontario Street is scheduled from September 22, 2025, to November 4, 2025.
- Construction work in the area is scheduled to take place from Monday to Sunday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m., with most days concluding at 7 p.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Businesses near work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Eastbound and westbound movements will not be permitted across at Courtneypark Drive.
- Lefthand turns from Hurontario Street onto Courtneypark Drive not be permitted.
- Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Courtneypark Drive will not be maintained.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
