Maple GO: Relocation of Switch Machine

September 29th, 2025 - October 17th, 2025 Overnight: Daily from 11:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.




Figure 1: Approximate area of work zone. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

What Is Happening

To support station enhancements at Maple GO, Metrolinx will be conducting work to relocate switch machines in the rail corridor near the McNaughton level crossing (see Figure 1). These activities will take place from September 29th until October 17th overnight between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

As the work is on the railtrack, it will need occur while there are no trains in service along the Barrie line to ensure the safety of site workers. We understand that overnight work is not ideal. Metrolinx will implement mitigations wherever possible to reduce the impact of the activities on residents in the area. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to bring better and faster service to Maple GO.



WHAT TO EXPECT

- Metrolinx will be relocating switch machines (see Figure 1 for approximate location).
- Equipment to be used include a pickup truck, crew truck, boom truck, directional drill, and hydro vac.
- Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with these activities, including near the access point. Site workers will make every effort to mitigate noise and will do their best to reduce any impacts to residents in the area.
- Trucks and other heavy equipment will not be left idling and instead shut off while not in use.
- Sound and air monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure that noise levels do not exceed a 65-decibel limit in compliance with Metrolinx's noise limits.
- Vibration monitors will be used as needed, depending on the nature of the work.
- Lights will be pointed towards the track to minimize any light pollution to the area.

HOURS OF WORK

• September 29th until October 17th overnight, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur along the rail tracks, just east of the McNaughton train crossing (see Figure 1).
- There will be an access point at McNaughton Road.

PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS

• There will be no pedestrian impacts.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

• There will be no traffic impacts.

TRANSIT IMPACTS

 This work will not impact GO service at Maple GO or along the Barrie line.
