

# Investigative work along Don Mills Road, near St. Dennis Drive

**When:** As early as late September 2025

**Hours of work:** Weekdays (Monday-Friday), 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.


**Duration of work:** One week

## What is happening?

- As part of the preparations for the upcoming Ontario Line elevated guideway construction, infiltration test drilling will begin as early as late September 2025 along Don Mills Road.
- The purpose of an infiltration test is to find out the amount of water in the native soil. These results will be integrated in the final drainage design and confirm the accuracy of the drainage strategy.

## What to expect

- An infiltration test involves drilling a hole, introducing a Guelph permeameter (instrument to measure the amount of water) and measure the amount of water in the native soil at the bottom of the hole.
- Work is expected to take approximately one (1) week to complete.
- The infiltration test drilling will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday.
- The drilling process will have minimal impacts on the surrounding area.
- Construction crews will use a drill rig, hydrovac truck, hydro-geological equipment, and survey equipment to gather information to progress with the design development phase.
