Occasional Closures at Graffiti Alley

Expected installation start date: As early as Oct. 6, 2025
Expected duration: Through October 2026
Work hours: 9 A.M. to 4 P.M.

What is happening?

To support construction at the future Ontario Line station at Queen-Spadina, crews will occasionally close Graffiti Alley to deliver materials to the south site.

What to expect

- Crews will occasionally close Graffiti Alley to deliver materials to the adjacent Ontario Line site.
- Deliveries are expected to be scheduled between 9 A.M. and 4 P.M. and are expected to be completed within two hours.
- Deliveries will begin as early as Oct. 6, 2025, and continue through October 2026.
- Residents and businesses in the area may hear noise from work equipment during this time. A crane may be used to move material from the alley into the site.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

Note:

- Work may be delayed, rescheduled, or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
