

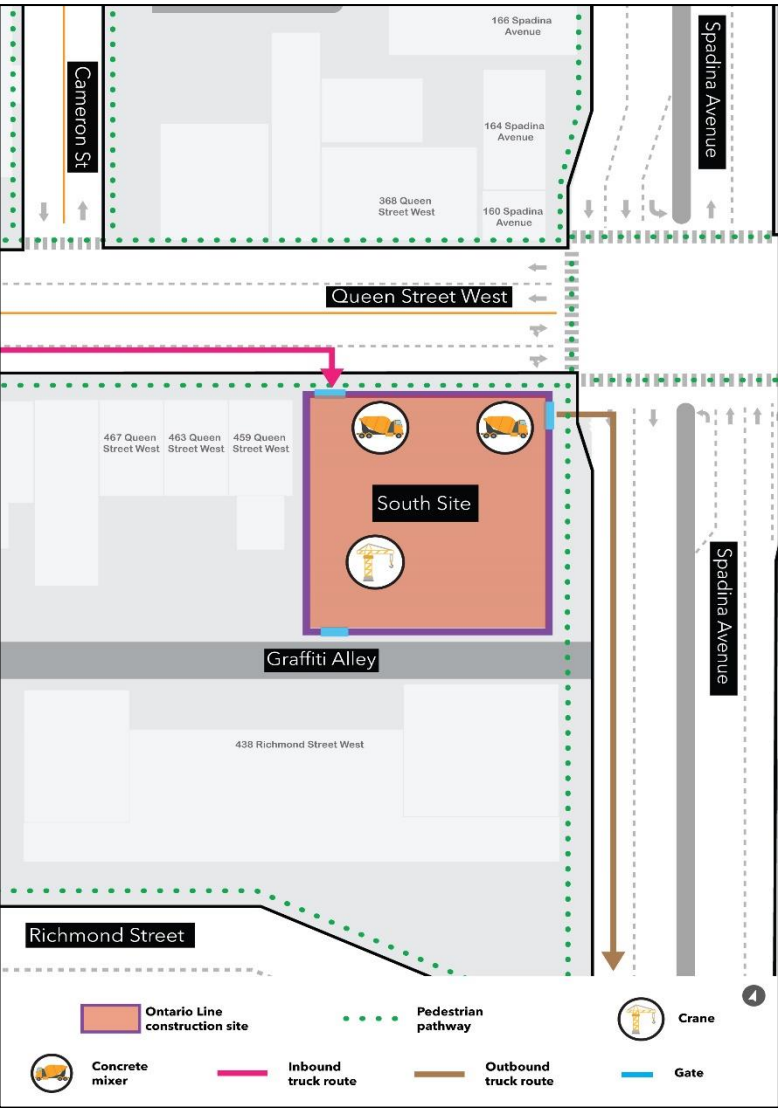
Concrete Pouring at Queen-Spadina

Expected start date: As early as, October 9th, 2025

Expected duration: One day

Hours of work: 5:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M.

What is happening?

Concrete is being poured for construction of support structures at the Queen-Spadina south site. This work must begin as early as 5:00 A.M. as the work cannot be stopped or paused once it has begun, and it is expected to take up to 16 hours to complete. This ensures it does take place during overnight hours.

What to expect

- The work is scheduled to begin as early as **October 9th, 2025**, and will operate from 5:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. for one day.
- Due to the nature of this work and the concrete pouring, this is work that cannot be paused or stopped once it has commenced.
- Residents can expect to hear and see several types of equipment during this phase, including concrete trucks and concrete pumps. Other equipment may be added or removed as necessary.
- Residents will also see an increase in trucks entering the site during the concrete pours.
- Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Mitigations are in place to limit the impact of debris and dirt on city streets.
- Crews may arrive on site earlier than 5:00 A.M. to prepare machinery and equipment.
- Work may be completed earlier than 11:00 P.M. depending on site progress.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled

due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

- Signage will be posted advising of any restrictions.
- Transit services will not be affected during this work and will remain in service.
