

Base slab concrete pour and delivery at Corktown

Expected start date: As early as Oct. 20, 2025
Expected duration: 12 shifts, over the next 18 months
Hours of work: 4:30 a.m. to 11 p.m.

What is happening?

As the Ontario Line station at Corktown continues to be built, the team is preparing to pour a thick reinforced concrete floor to form the bottom of the station shaft.

Because of the size of each section, concrete pours must be done in a single continuous pour to prevent weak points and ensure the structural integrity of the concrete. Over the next 18 months, approximately 12 extended concrete pours are scheduled. More information will be shared closer to the expected concrete pour dates.

What to expect

- 12 extended concrete pours will be scheduled over the next approximately 18 months.
- Each extended concrete pour is expected to take 12-16 hours. The work must be completed in a continuous cycle to ensure the structural integrity of the concrete.
- Neighbours will hear and see several types of construction equipment in use during this phase, including concrete trucks and concrete pumps, to name a few. Other equipment will be in use as required and may be added or removed from the site throughout the duration of work.
- Crews and cement mixers will arrive on site as early as 4:30 a.m. to prepare machinery and equipment.
- All construction schedules are subject to change and weather permitting.
