Long Branch GO: Platform Canopy Installation

Starting November 03 to December 03, 2025*




Figure 1: Map showcasing the work areas and access points. Please note: the size and boundaries of the site shown are not to scale.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Construction crews will be installing steel platform structures that will support the new platform canopies at Long Branch GO Station. Crews will deliver steel materials to site laydowns, move them into position with skid-steers and telehandlers, and use a crane, lifts, and welding to raise columns, beams, and decking. Work will take place on the north platforms during the day, from the North access point located on Edgeware Drive. Work will take place on the south platform overnight, from the access point on the south side of the tracks.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15-minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. This includes accessibility and amenity improvements to Toronto's Long Branch GO Station located at 20 Brow Drive in Etobicoke.



WHAT TO EXPECT

- **Please note:** canopy installations will generate a significant amount of noise.
- Crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment
 - White noise back up beacons on machinery
 - Noise monitoring with loud tasks strategically scheduled to reduce disruption

LOCATION OF WORK

 Work will take place on the north platform during the day (via Edgeware Drive Laydown access road) and on the south platform at night (via the southeast gate and planking along Track 3) - as shown in Figure 1.

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the vicinity of the site.
- Deliveries of construction materials will be coordinated to avoid peak periods of traffic.

- Daytime work will take place between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- Nighttime work will take place between 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
