Barrie GO Line: Road Closure on Castlefield Avenue




Figure 1: Map showing the approximate location of the road closure on Castlefield Ave. Not to sccale. For illustrative purposes only.

What You Need to Know

Castlefield Avenue will be closed on October 31 to November 3rd, 2025 in order to facilitate rail crossing rehabilitation work. Work will be conducted 24/7 throughout the weekend. Nearby residents and businesses can expect construction noise from heavy equipment and machinery.

State of Good Repair Work

State of Good Repair work helps keep Metrolinx's rail network safe, reliable, and comfortable for passengers by maintaining and upgrading critical infrastructure. This work prevents service disruptions, extends the life of assets, and supports the expansion of GO service with more frequent trips, new stations, cleaner technology, and better connections.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Construction crews will be carrying out rehabilitation work at the Castlefield Avenue rail crossing.
- Work includes the removal and replacement of ballast, track panels, and asphalt paving.
- Nearby residents and businesses may notice typical construction noise from equipment and activity.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will take place continuously from 9:00 PM on Friday, October 31st, until 6:00 AM on Monday, November 3rd.
- Crews will be working around the clock (day and night) throughout the weekend to complete the project as quickly as possible.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- A full road closure will be in place along Castlefield Avenue, both east and west of the rail crossing.
- Vehicles will not be able to travel across the rail corridor crossing.
- Local traffic will continue to have access to properties east and west of the rail corridor.

 Detour signage and traffic management staff will be in place to help guide traffic.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrian will not be able to travel across the rail corridor crossing.
- Pedestrians will continue to have access to properties east and west of the rail corridor.
- Please follow detour signage, stay on designated walkways, and exercise caution near the work zone.
