

UPDATED: Combined sewer construction on Pape Avenue south of Riverdale Avenue

Expected start: Mid-October 2025

Expected duration: One (1) year

Hours of Work: Weekdays: 7 am – 7 pm

What is happening?

- As early as mid-October crews will begin implementing a partial closure of Pape Avenue south of Riverdale Ave as the utility relocation work for the Gerrard Portal enters the next phase of work.
- During these phases crews will begin installation of the combined sewer and watermain on Pape Ave.

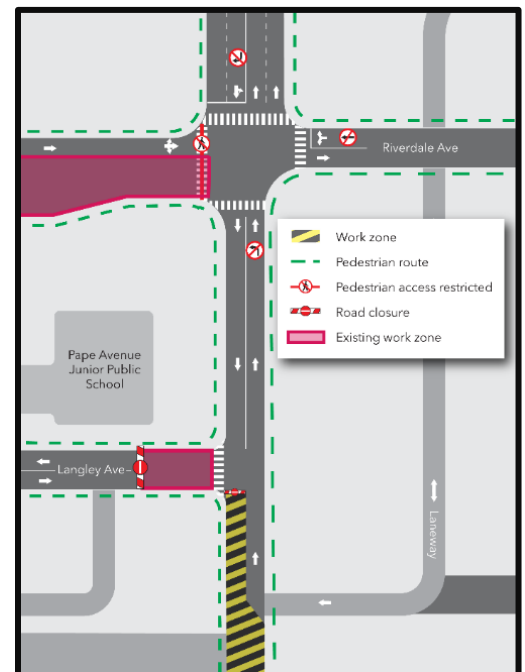
What to expect

- Equipment such as an excavator, backhoe, crane, triaxial truck, hydrovac truck and hand tools will be required to complete work.
- Paid Duty Officers, Traffic Control Personnel, and additional signage will be posted for traffic management.
- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to outline work zones.
- Noise, air quality, and vibration monitors will be in place. These devices will help to detect excessive noise and dust early to proactively conduct corrective actions as needed while crews drill piles.
- Construction equipment and materials will be securely stored within designated work zones to ensure safety and prevent unauthorized access.
- Work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.

Pedestrian and Traffic Impacts

Partial closure of Pape south of Langley - Approximately two (2) weeks

- Pape Avenue south of Langley Avenue will be closed to southbound traffic.
- One lane of northbound traffic will be maintained north of the laneway east of Pape Avenue.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout work.
- Traffic impacts implemented due to previously established work zones in the area will remain in place.



Partial closure of Pape south of Langley Avenue

Full closure of Pape south of Riverdale Avenue - Approximately eleven (11) months

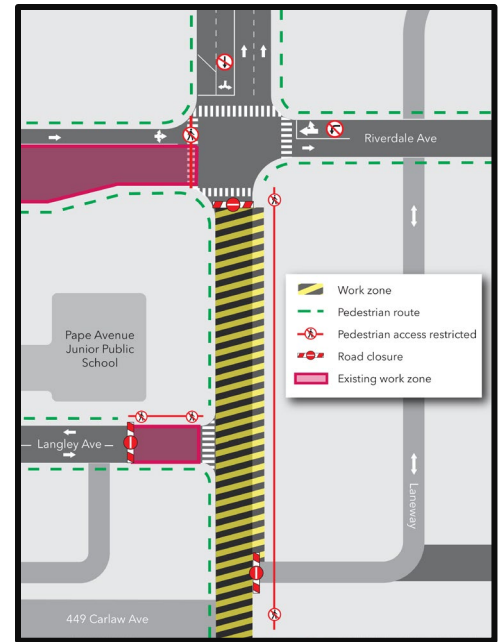
- This work is expected to start early November.
- Pape Avenue will be fully closed from Riverdale Avenue to the pedestrian bridge. Pedestrian access will at times be restricted on the east side of Pape Avenue between the pedestrian bridge and Riverdale Avenue, as well as north of the work zone on Langley Avenue.
- Traffic impacts implemented due to previously established work zones in the area will remain in place.

Partial Closure of Pape Riverdale - Approximately three (3) months

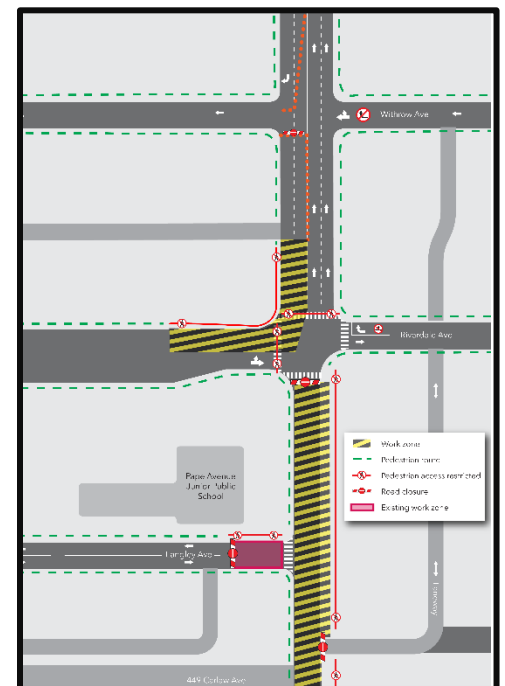
- This work is expected to start mid-November.
- In addition to the full closure of Pape Avenue south of Riverdale Avenue another work zone will be established at the northwest corner of the Pape-Riverdale intersection. To accommodate this work, cars traveling south on Pape will be required to turn right onto Withrow Avenue.
- The north-south crosswalk on the west side of the Pape-Riverdale intersection and the east-west crosswalk on the north side of the Pape-Riverdale intersection will be closed.
- Pedestrian access around the northwest corner of the Pape-Riverdale intersection will be restricted.
- Once this work at the northwest corner of the Pape-Riverdale intersection is complete the full closure of Pape south of Riverdale will remain, as noted above, however, Riverdale Avenue will be opened.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
