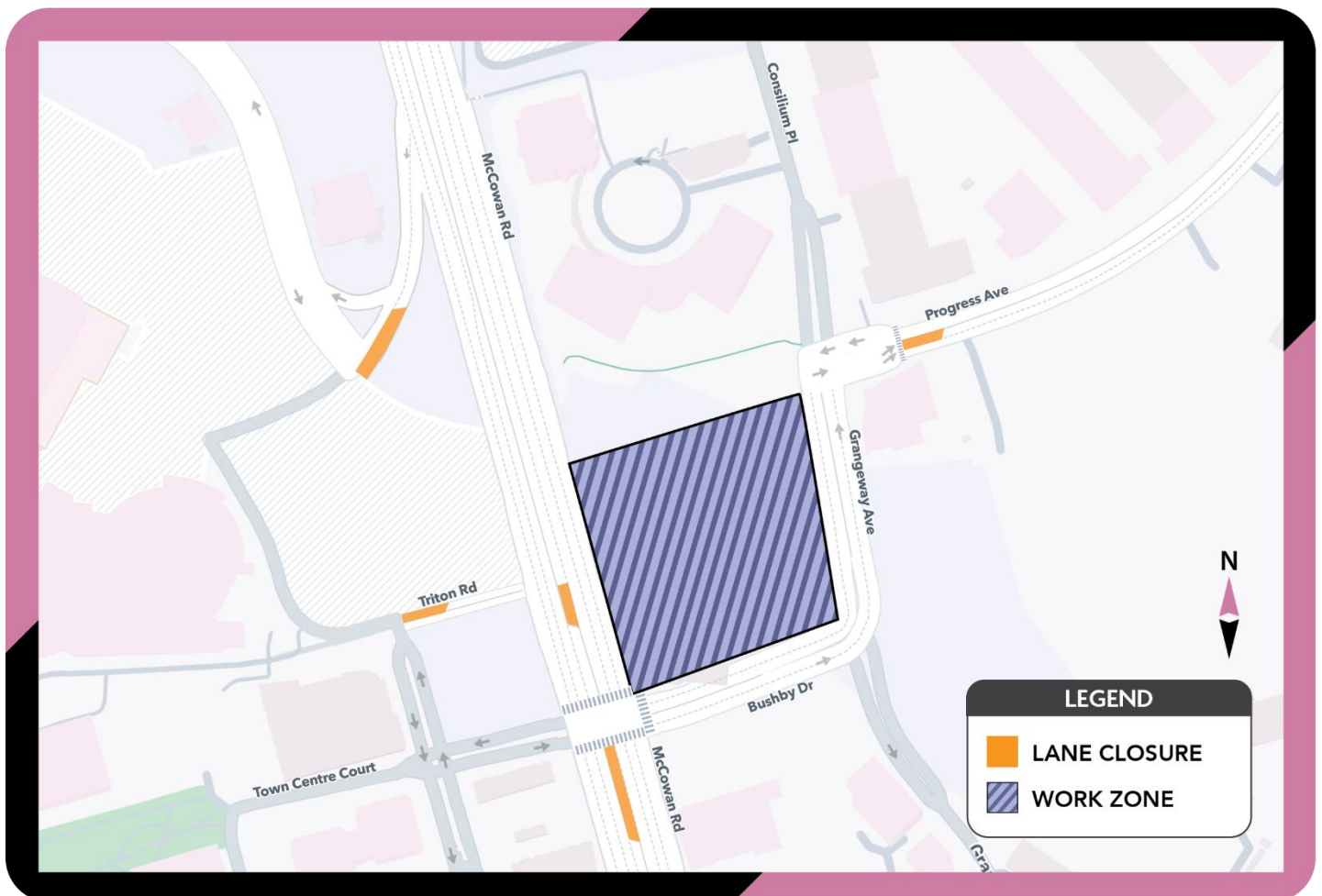


Sewer inspection work near Progress Avenue and McCowan Road

Schedule: October 27

Hours of Work: Weekdays 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., approximately

Note: Dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.



What is Happening

- To prepare for construction of the new Scarborough Centre Station, crews will be conducting sewer inspection work to document the condition of sewers in the vicinity of the Scarborough Centre Station construction zone.
- This work is a necessary step in our project preparation and due diligence for construction.

What to Expect

- Inspection work will take place on Progress near Grangeway, on McCowan Road north and south of Bushby Drive, and on Triton Road and Progress Avenue just west of McCowan Road.
- Work will include the use of a hydro-vac truck.
- A series of short-term lane closures, expected to last less than three hours each, will be required at each site.
- Paid Duty Officers and flaggers will be used, as required, to optimize traffic flow and ensure continued worker and public safety.
- Noise as a result of this work is not expected to exceed city noise guidelines.

About the Project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
