
# Nightly road closures on Dundas Street East for traffic reconfiguration

#### **Dates and hours of work:**

- From Tuesday November 4 to Thursday, November 6, 2025
- Road closures occur nightly between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.



#### What is happening?

- Dundas Street East will be closed nightly from Tuesday November 4 to Thursday, November 6, 2025, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- These road closures are required to implement traffic and pedestrian changes that are needed to build the new Dundas bridge.
- Due to space constraints, this work can only be done safely when the road is closed.
- The closure will start at West Avenue and end at Logan Avenue. Access for residents and businesses will be maintained.
- Overnight work will be required during the road closure to make sure all activities are completed in time for the road to reopen in the morning.
- More disruptive work will be scheduled during the day to minimize overnight noise.
- After the road closures are completed, a new traffic stage will be in place. This traffic stage will allow crews to build the centre piers for the new bridge.



#### **Traffic and pedestrian details**

### Nightly road closures (from Nov. 4 - Nov 6, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.)

- No traffic, pedestrians or cyclists will be allowed beneath the Dundas Street East bridge.
- Access for residents and businesses (local traffic) will be maintained east of Broadview Avenue and west of Logan Avenue.
- Road closure signage will be posted at Broadview Avenue and Logan Avenue to direct drivers.
- Traffic will be diverted both ways via Broadview Avenue, Queen Street East, Logan Avenue and Carlaw
- Cyclists will be diverted both ways via Boulton Avenue, De Grassi Street, First Avenue, Gerrard Street East and Logan Avenue.
- Advance signage will be in place to notify drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of the closure.
- Paid duty officers will be stationed at each end of the road closure to help drivers, pedestrians and cyclists navigate the area.

## Centre pier construction (starting Nov. 7)

- Traffic on Dundas Street will be diverted to the sides of the road. A construction zone will be installed in the middle of the road.
- The sidewalk on the north side of Dundas Street will be closed and the sidewalk on the south side of Dundas Street will be open.
- Advance signage will be posted to direct pedestrians.
- The bike lanes on Dundas Street will remain closed.
- Cyclists will need to share the road with vehicles while travelling through this area. Share the road signs will be posted to guide drivers and cyclists.
- Drivers are reminded to slow down and allow cyclists to safely merge into the traffic lane. Do not attempt to pass cyclists.
- Traffic may be stopped for short durations during lifting operations or to allow for the safe entry/exit of construction equipment.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Dundas Street East throughout the work.
- These traffic changes will be put in place overnight to avoid delays to the travelling public.

#### What to expect

- Nightly closures of Dundas Street between West Avenue and Logan Avenue.
- Noise from construction activities including equipment relocations, traffic barrier placement, installing pedestrian covered ways, and traffic line painting and removal.
- Noise mitigation measures, including temporary noise barriers and noise reducing equipment, will be used as required.
- Construction vehicles will enter/exit the site from the access road off Dundas Street.
- Clear signage will be in place to direct vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.
- Traffic barrels, fencing and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
