
Main Track Closure: Grading and Surfacing across the Lakeshore East Corridor

November 14 - November 17 2025



Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As the current phase of GO Expansion work in your area nears completion, crews will be working to address various remaining items across the rail corridor. The scope of work may include the usage of a tamping machine, which compacts the sub-ballast stones beneath the tracks, as well as grading activities using a dozer machine. As such, residents may experience noise and vibrations during the operation of these machines. Due to the wide array of items to address, the work will be conducted intermittently across various locations. The schedule of work is subject to change based on weather conditions and unforeseen elements. Crews are aiming to complete a large portion of work during the weekend track closure while the trains are not running.



Construction activity	Timescale and work period	Description of work
Grading and surfacing work	During the closure of the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor on the weekend of November 14-17. This work is being done during daytime and nighttime hours while trains are not operating on the rail corridor.	Metrolinx will be conducting various construction activities, including but not limited to: • Grading works to create final elevations of subballast across the corridor. • Tamping of sub-ballast to ensure a smooth and stable layer under the train tracks.

HOURS OF WORK

 This work will take place during daytime and nighttime hours from the evening of November 14 to 5 am on November 17.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Residents can expect some noise, vibration, dust near the work areas.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and communities, including:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - White noise backup alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
 - Safely securing work zones.
 - Noise and vibration monitoring as required.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience as we complete this critical work.

- Work areas will be set up with clear signage and delineation.
- No impacts to traffic or pedestrians
- Please exercise caution in and around work areas.
- No train service on the Lakeshore East line between November 15-16.
