Strachan Avenue to Exhibition delivery ramp connection


Expected start date: Wednesday, Nov. 12, 2025

Hours of work: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Wednesdays to Fridays, with additional sidewalk closures from 9

a.m. to 3 p.m. from November 12 -14.

What is happening?

Construction is ongoing to deliver the Ontario Line at Exhibition. To enhance safety and efficiency during tunnelling operations, crews are installing a delivery ramp off Strachan Avenue into the Exhibition Station site.

Crews will continue to work on key elements of the project, including foundations and excavation for the new station entrances, platform works, the Ontario Line tunnel portal, tunnel boring machine support structures and a traction power substation in the area. These activities will proceed during regular hours as outlined in previous notices.

What to expect

- The southbound lane on Strachan Avenue will be closed during work, with traffic diverted to the northbound lane. The lane will reopen once work is completed. Flaggers will be positioned on both sides of the work zone to safely manage traffic flow.
- The southbound bike lane and sidewalk will be closed near the work zone during the work and will reopen once it is finished.
- Neighbours will see and hear various construction equipment during this phase, such as concrete trucks, dump trucks, rollers, and asphalt pavers. Additional equipment may be used as needed and could be added or removed from the site throughout the project.



- From Wednesday, Nov. 12, 2025, to Friday, Nov. 14, 2025, sidewalk and bike lane closures will occur during daytime hours, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Crews may arrive on site earlier than 9 p.m. to prepare machinery and equipment.
- All construction schedules are subject to change and weather permitting.
