
# Sidewalk closure on McCowan Road north of Ellesmere Road

**Duration:** November 12-13, 2025 and November 17 - 20, 2025.

Note: Dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.





## What is happening?

- Starting in November 2025, crews will begin reinstating the sidewalks, pedestrian push-buttons, traffic poles and the median near the FreshCo on McCowan Road north of Ellesmere Road.
- Crews successfully built an underground support structure at the site and are completing restoration work at this location.

#### Pedestrian and vehicle diversions

- From November 12<sup>th</sup> 13<sup>th</sup> during the daytime and from November 17<sup>th</sup> through 20<sup>th</sup>, throughout the entire day, the sidewalk on the western side of McCowan Road between Ellesmere Road and Bushby Drive and Town Centre Court will be closed for pedestrian access. With sidewalk west of McCowan Road closed; cross at McCowan Road and Ellesmere Road or McCowan Road and Bushby Drive to access sidewalk on the east side.
- Existing traffic lane restrictions in this area may still be in place as crews safely reinstate McCowan Road.
- Diversions will be indicated with signage and barriers, and traffic control personnel will safely guide pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

## What to expect?

- Nearby residents may hear noise from construction activity. Crews will be monitoring the activity and will take steps to mitigate noise where possible.
- Traffic barrels, fencing and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- To ensure pedestrian and driver safety, construction crews will occasionally temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks along McCowan Road. Signage will alert drivers and pedestrians to these temporary closures and detours.

#### **About the project**

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buss, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
