

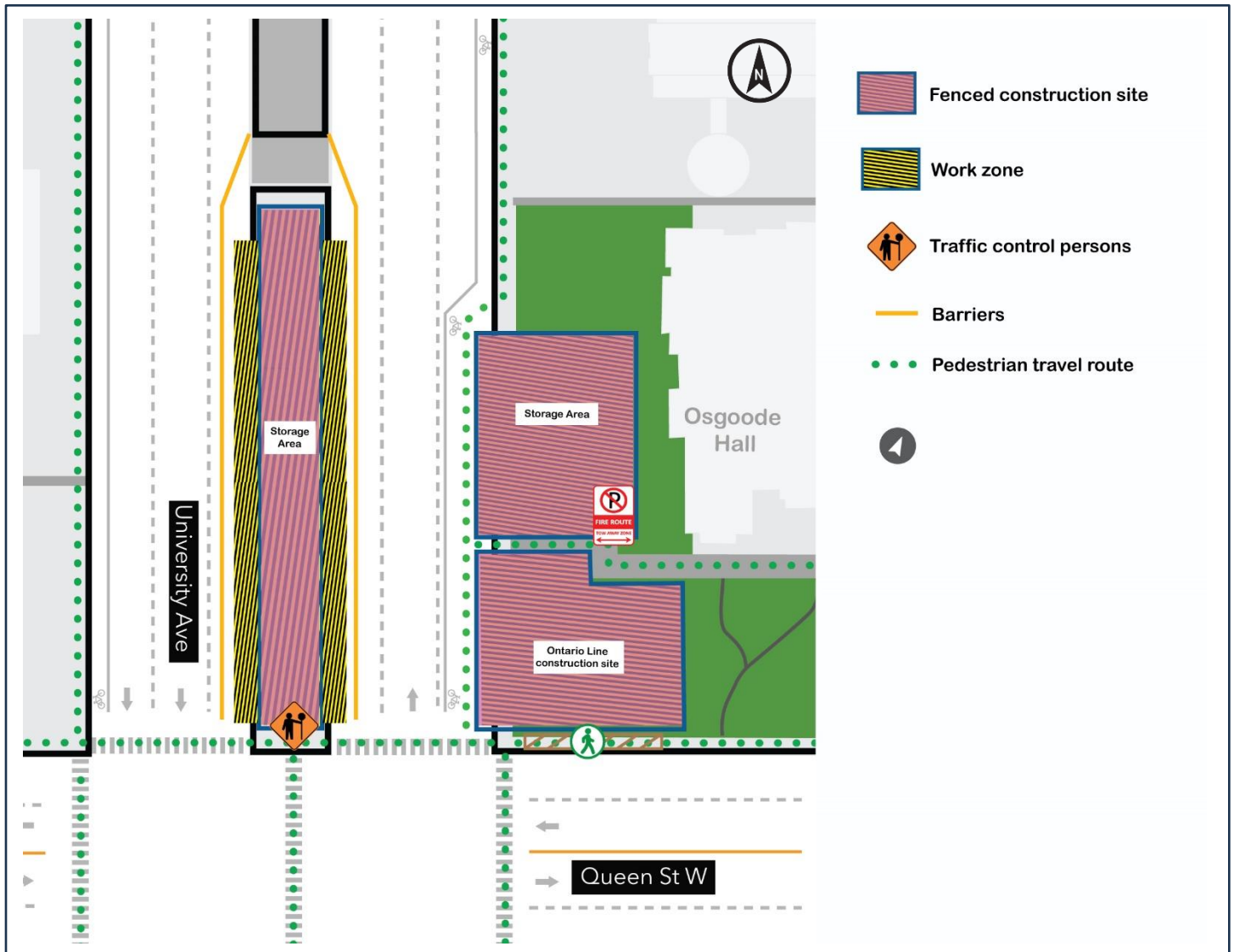
Signage installation on University Avenue

Expected start date: Monday, Dec. 1, 2025

Expected end date: Up to one (1) week

Hours of work: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday to Friday

What is happening?

- Signage panels will be installed on the hoarding around the perimeter fencing of the construction zone in the median along University Avenue.
- To ensure public safety, northbound and southbound lanes on University Avenue will be partially closed during installation (see map).
- Work will begin as early as Monday, Dec. 1, 2025, and it is expected to take up to one (1) week.

What to expect

- Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. from Monday to Friday. Additional working hours, including Saturday shifts, may be required.
- Crews are expected to be on-site before 9 p.m. to set up equipment.
- During this work, crews will implement intermittent partial closures of the inside lanes in the northbound and southbound lanes along the median on University Avenue.
- Flag-persons will be present to assist pedestrians across the sidewalk on Queen Street West and University Avenue.
- Safety barriers will be used to separate pedestrians and motorists from the work zones.
- Northbound and southbound traffic will be maintained in four of the five lanes, with only one lane in either direction being closed during the installation.
- Clear signage will be posted for transit riders, pedestrians, and motorists.
- Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- All construction schedules are subject to change and weather permitting.
