

Start of permanent station work at King-Bathurst

When: November 2025 to end of 2028

Hours of work:

- **South site:** 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, as needed
- **North site:** (Cavern): 24-hours a day, seven days a week

What is happening:

Crews are approaching the end of the excavation phase at the King-Bathurst south station site as they finish shaping the underground space to begin permanent works for the future Ontario Line station and tunnels. Foundation work on the north site station is ready to begin.

Crews will begin installing:

- **On the South site:** Permanent waterproofing membranes will be applied to the station's underground walls to prevent water from seeping in, avoiding leaks and water damage.

- **On the North site:** Pouring concrete elements: Crews will start constructing the structure of the station structure. The first major structural element is the base slab that will form the foundation of the station box.

What to expect:

- Expected on-site construction equipment includes various concrete sprayers, telehandlers, boom lifts, concrete mixers and pumps, troweling machines, and other machinery as required.
- Residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from construction equipment as they move into the stations and begin work.
- **On the south:** Working hours are **not expected to extend beyond 11:00 P.M.** except in unforeseen circumstances requiring immediate action to ensure site safety before departure.
- Crews will arrive on-site before the start of work to set up equipment.
- Vehicle traffic will access worksites daily via designated routes from Stewart Street to Portland Street gates for the south site, and from Bathurst Street to Adelaide Street for the north site.
- To minimize impacts on residents and businesses in the area, mitigations include air quality, noise, and vibration monitoring, street cleaning, site hoarding, additional paved areas, sprinkler systems, and mud mats for dust control.
