# Davenport Diamond Greenway

# **Project Overview**

The Davenport Diamond Greenway will be a new public space in Toronto's west end.

Located between Davenport Road and Paton Road, just north of Bloor Street West, the greenway will run beneath the elevated GO train tracks and transform the space for the community. New amenities include:

- A fully accessible multi-use path
- A pedestrian bridge over the freight tracks, north of Dupont Street
- Access to the greenway from city sidewalks and parks
- New neighbourhood spaces, including Dupont Bridge Square and Wallace Avenue Market Square, will feature benches and lighting
- Sustainable landscaping, plantings and gardens
- A dog off-leash area



## **Benefits**

- Outdoor spaces designed for people to enjoy within a vibrant and diverse neighbourhood
- The multi-use path and pedestrian bridge will improve connectivity in the area
- Accessing the greenway will be convenient with new paths linking to sidewalks and parks on both the east and west sides at Paton Road, Wallace Avenue, Sarnia Avenue, Campbell Park, Dupont Street, Davenport Village Park, and Davenport Road
- A variety of native plant species will be planted to support healthy soil and natural habitats

## **GO** Expansion

The greenway is one way we are improving communities we serve and is part of Metrolinx's larger GO Expansion program. The program is transforming the GO rail network into a rapid rail system that will bring more frequent service in both directions. This means more transit options to help connect people to jobs and families and to more destinations across the region.
