

# Bain Ave and Pape Ave Replacement Parking Now Available

**Expected start date:** Replacement parking is available as of December 15, 2025

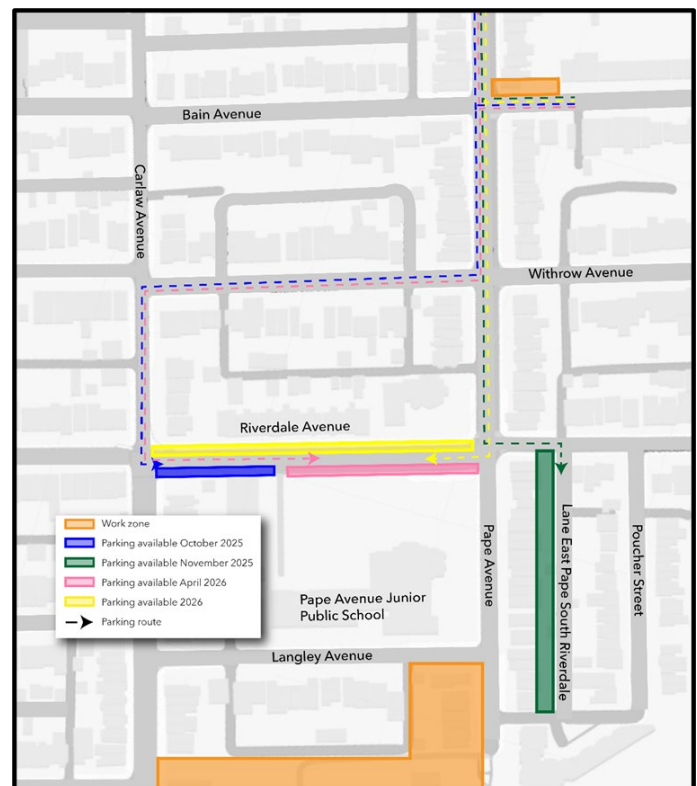
**Expected duration:** Approximately 4 years

## What is happening?

- As a result of the construction of the Bain emergency exit building (EEB) at the corner of Pape Avenue and Bain Avenue, some on-street permit parking restrictions have been put in place around the intersection.
- Generally, a total of 11 spaces will be impacted while up to 25 spaces could be impacted short-term and during Stage 5 of the work at the Bain EEB, starting in Summer 2027.

## What to expect

- Metrolinx has made 21 replacement parking spaces available near to Pape Avenue and Bain Avenue for residents that have City of Toronto street parking permits.
- The location of the parking spaces is indicated by the green box in the figure to the right.
- Lane "S Riverdale E Pape" is located south of Riverdale Avenue and east of Pape Avenue. These spaces will be approximately 200 metres from Bain Avenue/Pape Avenue and are about a 2-3 minute walk from the current parking spaces.
- Please note that parking is provided on a "first-come first-served" basis and residents are requested to only park in designated spots identified by pavement markings. Areas that are not designated for parking will have clear "No Parking" signage.
- Metrolinx is in the process of installing enhanced lighting at the parking spaces. In addition, Metrolinx will have regular patrols by a third-party security firm and will conduct regular snow clearing and salting of the parking spaces and laneway. While Metrolinx is taking best efforts to ensure the safety of the parking spaces, vehicles are parked at your own risk. However, we installed "No Parking" warning signs to deter unauthorized parking.
