Metrolinx and its employees are committed to understanding the history of these lands and the continued impacts of colonization and take responsibility for actions to advance reconciliation.

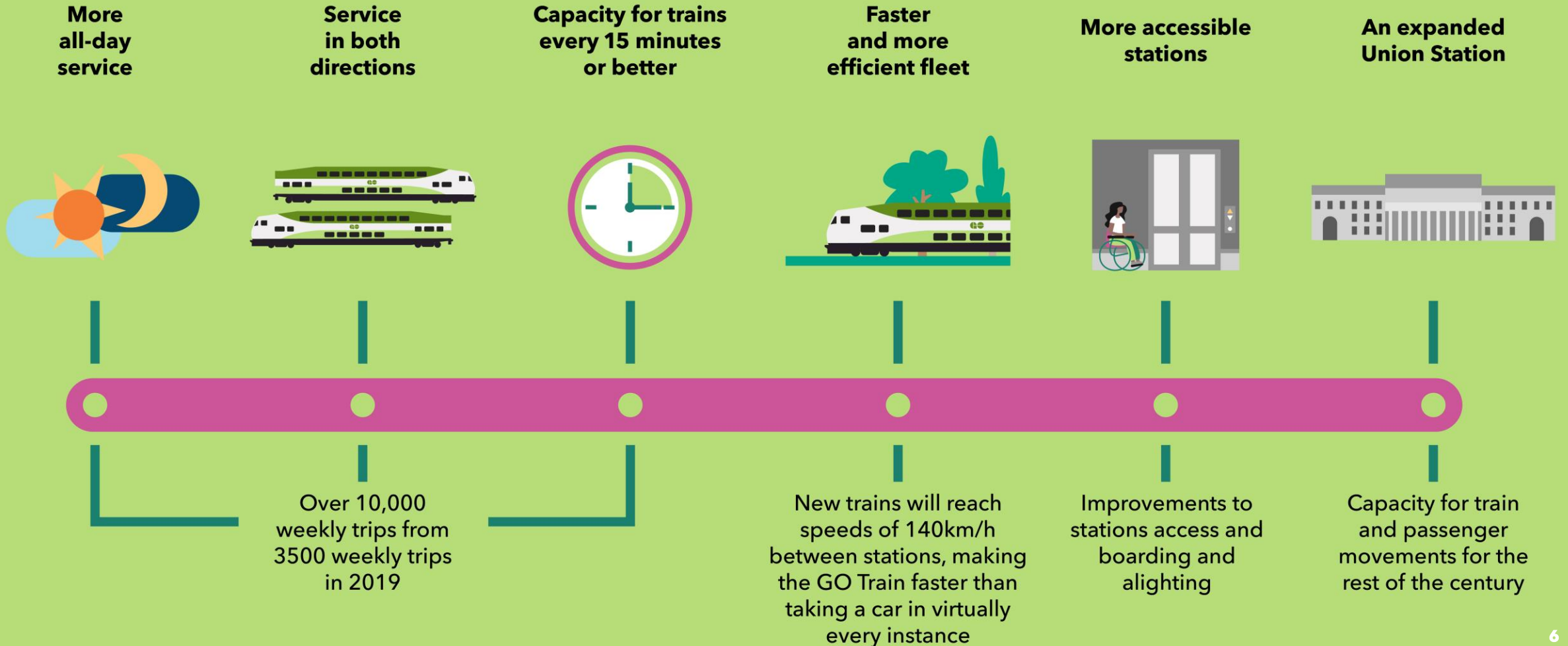

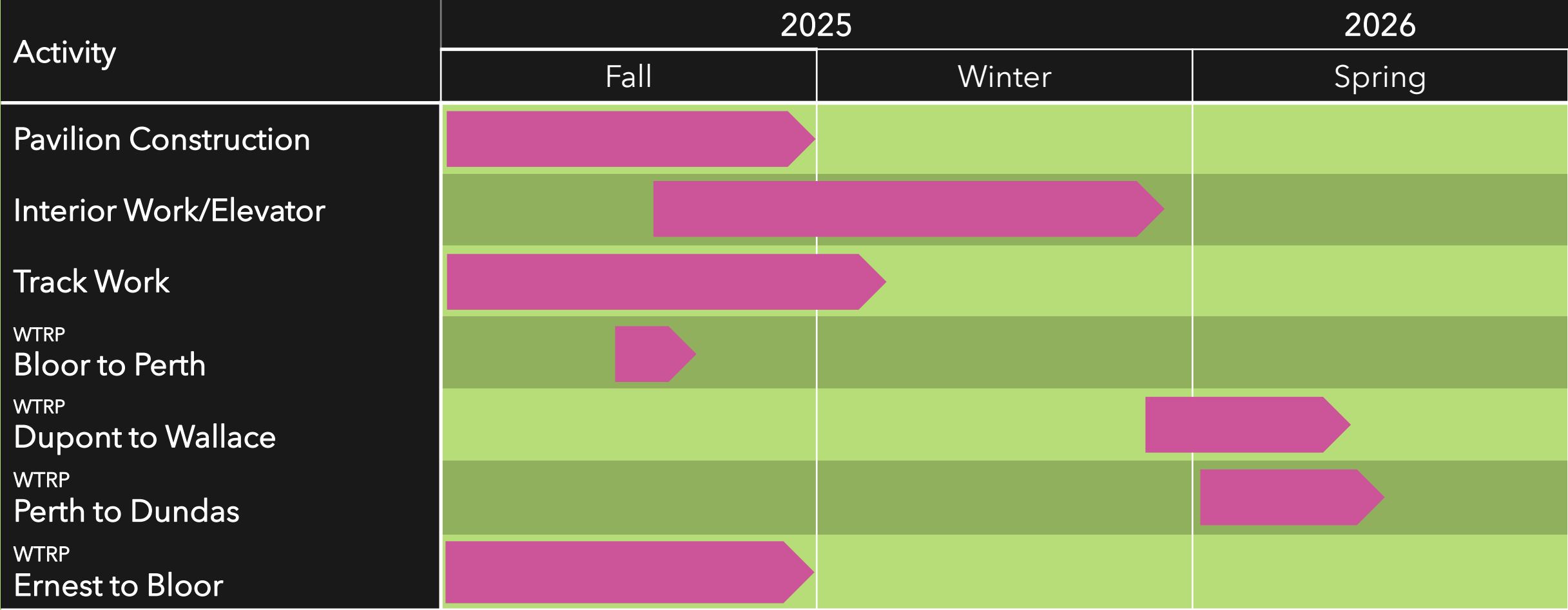

UPDATE ON ERNEST AVENUE TEMPORARY PLATFORM ACCESS

- Thank you to everyone who raised concern about the closure of the Ernest Avenue temporary platform access at Bloor GO Station.
- Our team is exploring possible alternatives to maintain access on the east side of the station and is working to identify a potential solution that minimizes the impact to the community and customers, while maintaining reasonable construction project timelines and budgets. At this time, the **Ernest Avenue access will remain open while we continue to assess the situation.**
- Any new information or updates will be shared with the community as soon as they are available.

- Segment 5 of the Railpath
 - Bloor St to Perth Ave w opened on Dec 10, ahead of schedule
 - Includes stairs on south side of Bloor St
 - Asphalt paving between Bloor St and Randolph Ave

- Pavilion/Tunnel
 - Electrical and communications work
 - Mechanical equipment installation
 - Stone veneer cladding installation
 - Architectural metal panel installation
