

Barrie GO Line shoring works

Monday, January 5 2026 - March 2026

WHAT IS HAPPENING

Metrolinx will be conducting shoring works to prepare the site for upcoming construction activities. Shoring is a critical step in ensuring the safety and stability of future infrastructure and readying the site for full construction. Work will take place from Monday, January 5, 2026, to March 2026.

Work will occur during weekdays only between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. to ensure the safety of workers who require access to the rail corridor. We understand that overnight work may be disruptive. Metrolinx will make every effort to minimize impacts to the community and maintain public safety throughout this period.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Structural supports will be installed to stabilize the ground and surrounding infrastructure for future construction activities. This requires caisson drilling within the designated work zone (see Figure 1).
- Equipment to be used includes a drill rig, delivery and dump trucks, and steel beams.
- Noise, dust and vibration: While drilling works will result in periodic noise, dust, and vibration, these impacts will be actively monitored, and every effort will be made to mitigate exposure to nearby residents. No equipment will be left to idle.
- Light: All lights will be pointed towards the track.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur overnight between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- Work is anticipated to begin during overnight hours and transitioning into daytime construction work zones
- Residents may experience a mix of daytime and nighttime work.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur north of Eglinton Avenue West.
- Work will occur within the rail corridor.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- At this time, no impacts on sidewalks or pedestrian pathways are expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Deliveries and equipment will enter the work zone at Carnarvon Street.
- Traffic controllers will manage these entries/exits as needed.
- There is no other major traffic impacts expected.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- Nearby GO Transit and TTC service will not be impacted.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Metrolinx has a dedicated community engagement team in place that works with residents and businesses in the Toronto West area.
