

UPDATE: Track Work at Hurontario Street and Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd

January 7 - February 11, 2026



What work is taking place?

Necessary track rework at Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd, will begin on **Wednesday January 7, 2026 at 10 p.m.**, until **Wednesday February 11, 2026 at 10 p.m.** This rework is required to ensure safe operations of the future light rail vehicles.

The work will require partial east-west intersection closure and left-turn restrictions at the intersection of Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd and Hurontario. Crews will be performing rework including track installation and concrete pouring. **Detour routes will be available via Kateson Drive, Capston Drive, World Drive, and Edwards Blvd.**

Construction work at this intersection may be scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd will not be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

Transit services will be impacted by these temporary intersection closures. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates and www.brampton.ca/transit for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. TIMING

- Work at Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd and Hurontario Street is scheduled from January 7, 2026 to February 11, 2026.
- Construction work at this intersection may be scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRANSIT IMPACT DETAILS

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Businesses near work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Eastbound and westbound movements will not be permitted across at Hurontario.
- Lefthand turns from Hurontario onto Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd will not be permitted.
- Lefthand turns from Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd onto Hurontario Street will not be permitted.
- Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Prologis Blvd/Annagem Blvd will not be maintained.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
