

# UPDATE: Track Work at Hurontario Street and Traders Blvd/Aldridge St.

January 19 - February 19, 2026



## What work is taking place?

Necessary track rework at Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. will begin on Monday January 19, 2026, at 10 p.m. until Thursday February 19, 2026, at 10 p.m. This rework is required to ensure safe operations of the future light rail vehicles.

The work will require partial east-west intersection closure and left-turn restrictions at the intersection of Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. and Hurontario. Crews will be performing rework including track installation and concrete pouring. Detour routes will be available via Milverton Dr, Watline Ave, Sandstone Dr, and Brunel Rd.

Construction work at this intersection may be scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. will not be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. ## **TIMING**

- Work at Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. and Hurontario Street is scheduled from January 19, 2026, to February 19, 2026.
- Construction may be scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## **WHAT TO EXPECT**

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Businesses near work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

## **TRAFFIC DETAILS**

- Eastbound and westbound movements will not be permitted across at Hurontario.
- Lefthand turns from Hurontario onto Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. will not be permitted.
- Lefthand turns from Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. onto Hurontario Street will not be permitted.
- Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Traders Blvd/Aldridge St. will not be maintained.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
