


Underground utility investigations on Bloor Street near Durham College Oshawa GO Station

As early as January 26th to early February 2026

Project overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion program, we will be using a hydrovac truck to locate underground infrastructure and assess ground conditions on Bloor Street West near Durham College Oshawa GO Station and the Lakeshore East rail corridor. This work will support future track and infrastructure updates.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Businesses, motorists and the public may notice crews working in the areas shown on the map.
- Crews will locate and expose underground utilities and infrastructure using a hydrovac truck and hand tools to drill through surfaces in selected areas and excavate small test holes—typically 1 to 2 metres deep and 6 to 8 inches wide.
- Once complete, all test holes will be backfilled and compacted to restore the surface.
- Short periods of noise and vibration near close to roadway and parking lot entrances.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and businesses, including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - Safely secured work areas.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in the areas shown on the map.
- Work may be rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC CHANGES

- One lane will be closed at a time and traffic will be maintained in each direction.
- Traffic control personnel will direct vehicles through the area.

TRANSIT SERVICE:

- Please proceed with caution near work areas.
