

Tree removals and archaeological investigations at 8000 Yonge Street

Expected timeline: as early as February 16, 2026 to June 1, 2026 *(Protective fencing to be installed in advance)*

Timing: Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

What is happening?

To support future construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension, crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be carrying out early site preparation work at 8000 Yonge Street. This includes an archaeological excavation, which requires the removal of topsoil as well as seven trees. Vegetation within the property will also be pruned and mowed. These steps are needed to make sure future construction work related to Royal Orchard Station can move forward safely and efficiently. Before tree removal work begins, the area will be carefully checked for wildlife and active bird nests, and work will move forward following all required environmental and wildlife protection measures.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension:

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending TTC Line 1 subway service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The project includes five new subway stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

WORK DETAILS:

- Protective fencing will be installed around trees near the excavation area, where needed. Installation of fencing is expected to take place in advance of work commencing.
- Seven trees will be removed within the property, and other trees will be pruned.
- Following the installation of protective fencing, tree removals will commence in accordance with municipal requirements.
- Crews will carry out a controlled archaeological excavation, which includes removing and disposing of topsoil.
- This work is expected to take approximately 12 weeks to complete.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- You may hear noise from equipment and trucks, including loaders, chainsaws, and woodchippers, while work is underway.
- Where needed, protective barriers will be installed around trees that are being preserved in advance of work commencing.
- Additional site clearing will happen later as work moves forward.

- Work is scheduled to take place on weekdays between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
