

Cosburn Station

Support of Excavation Construction

Expected start date: Late January 2026

Expected duration: Approximately 5 months

Hours of Work: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

What is happening?

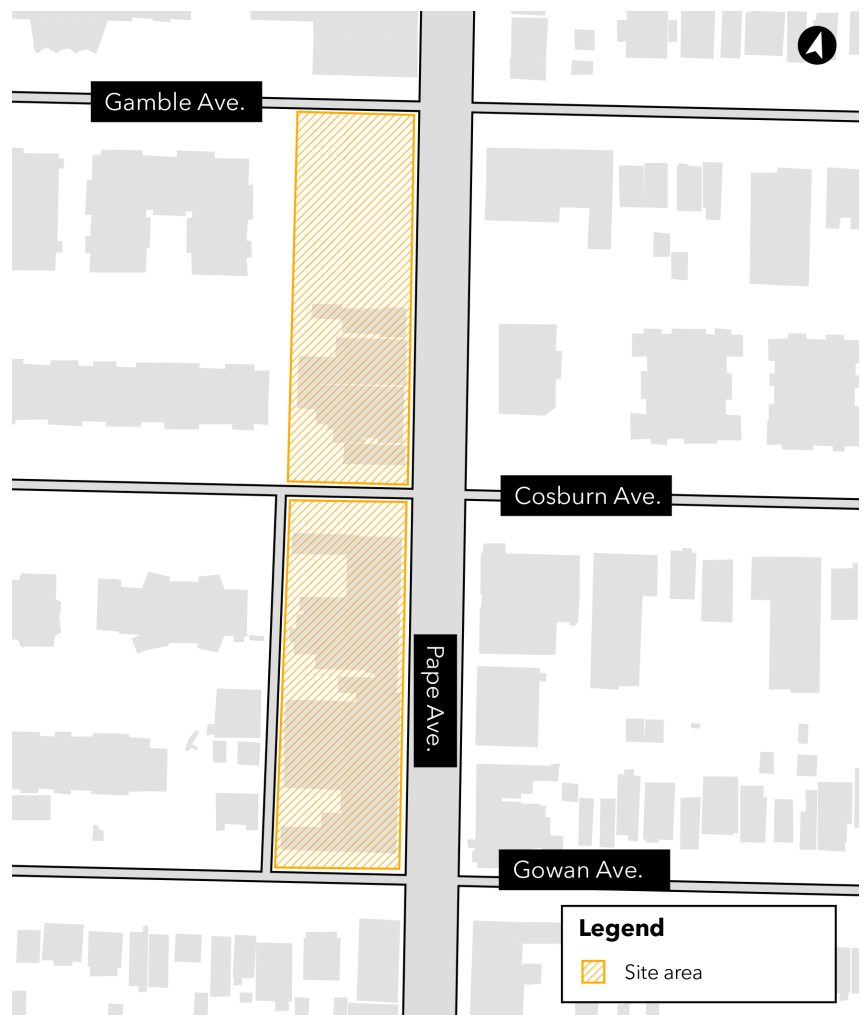
- The future Cosburn Station will be located at the west corner of Pape Avenue between Gamble Avenue and Gowan Avenue.
- The next phase of construction will involve ground improvement work to prepare the Cosburn Station site for excavation.

Work completed to date

- Utility relocations and structural demolition on the northwest and southwest sides of Pape Avenue and Cosburn Avenue.
- Ground and soil quality investigations.

What to expect

- To transition from a demolition site, crews will begin preparing equipment in late January to install semi-permanent hoarding, signage and noise barriers in preparation for ground improvement activities.
- Ground improvement work will take up to five months.
- Work will take place during weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances could affect construction hours.
- Environmental monitoring equipment will be placed on site to assess noise, vibration and dust levels from trucks and heavy construction equipment during construction.



Traffic and pedestrian impacts

Trucks will enter and exit the work site following approved truck routes, avoiding residential streets. Find the approved hauling routes by visiting [metrolinx.com/OntarioLineTSP](https://www.metrolinx.com/OntarioLineTSP)

What's next?

Construction of temporary roads to accommodate building a traffic deck. The traffic deck will serve as a bridge to allow motor vehicles access to the roadway while excavation work is conducted below the intersection at Pape Avenue and Cosburn Avenue.
