

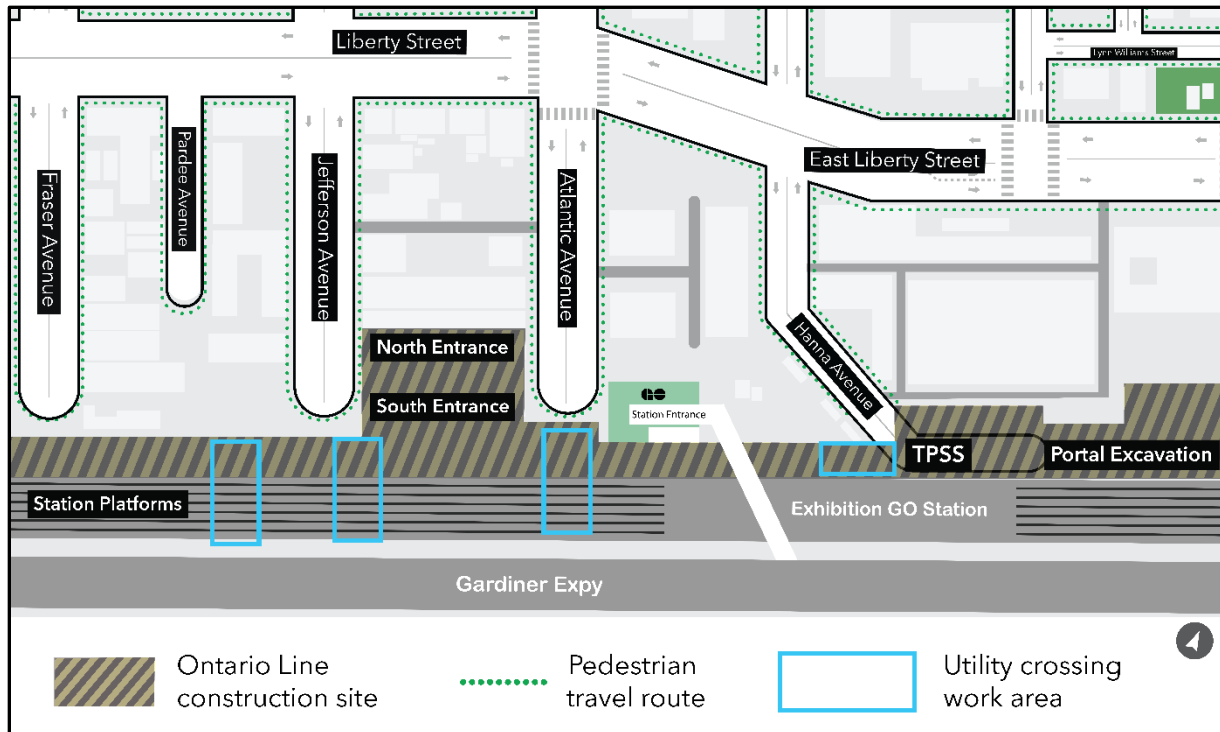

What is happening?

To accommodate the future Ontario Line subway and the expanded Exhibition Station, underground utility work will take place beneath the GO Lakeshore West rail corridor and the future Exhibition Station.

This phase of work will take place overnight in several locations throughout the site, between the future station platforms and the TPSS (traction power substation).

What to expect

- During this phase of construction, crews will use trucks and trailers to deliver equipment and remove materials, along with equipment such as excavators, auger bores, skid steer and other demolition equipment to connect a small tunnel under the rail corridor. A hydrovac machine may be used as needed.

- Work will take place six (6) days a week, Monday through Saturday, in overnight shifts from 7:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.
- There is no expected impact to GO Transit operations or service.
- Residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from equipment working between the Gardiner Expressway, the rail corridor and the Ontario Line work zone.
- Work may be postponed or re-scheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
