

Temporary Turn and Lane Restrictions, Sidewalk Closure and Road Closure of Floradale Drive at Hurontario Street for Hydro Pole Installations

Right turn restriction from Floradale to Hurontario and south sidewalk closure: February 2 to mid-February 2026

Floradale Drive Closure: February 3, 2026, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.



What work is taking place?

Crews will be installing hydro (electrical poles) on the south side of Floradale Drive near Hurontario Street. Site preparation will begin on February 2, 2026, and then followed by pole installation and cable pulling into mid-February.

Right turns from Floradale Drive onto Hurontario Street will be restricted and the south sidewalk on Floradale Drive near Hurontario Street will be closed from February 2, 2026 to mid-February during working hours from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will also be a restriction of a southbound lane on Hurontario Street during this work. Detours will be available through Hurontario Street, Paisley Road and Confederation Parkway. Please follow posted signage.

Floradale Drive will be temporarily closed on February 3, 2026 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. to install the poles. Emergency vehicle access will always be maintained through the duration of all works.

TIMING

- Right turns from Floradale Drive to Hurontario Street will be restricted for the duration of this work starting February 2, 2026, as well as a restriction of a southbound lane on Hurontario Street.
- Floradale Drive at Hurontario Street will be closed on February 3, 2026, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

- Detours during these works include Confederation Parkway, Paisley Road and Hurontario Street.
