

St. Clair-Old Weston Station: Caisson Drilling and Shoring Works

Monday, February 9, 2026 – Monday, March 16, 2026

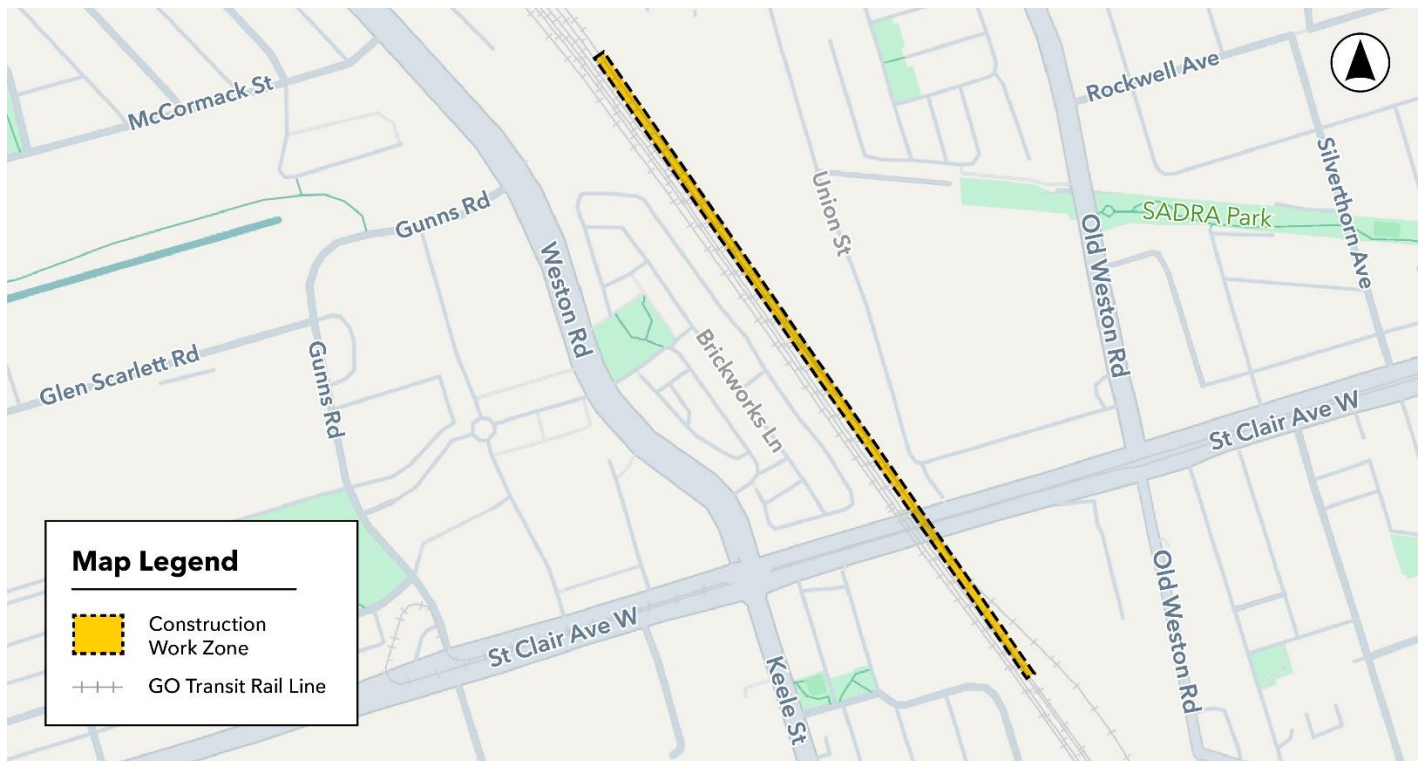


Figure 1: Approximate zone for drilling works. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

WHAT IS HAPPENING

As part of preparatory works to ready the site of the future St. Clair - Old Weston Station for construction, crews will be working within the rail corridor to construct a drill rig pad, conduct drilling works, and pour concrete for caissons, which will serve as ground strengthening for the future pedestrian tunnel and bridge.

This work will be completed behind a Continuous Work Zone, which enables crews to perform work safely during the day and at night.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work activities include material delivery, excavation, delivery and set-up of a drill rig, drilling, and concrete pouring.
- Crews will be using heavy machinery, including a drill rigs, excavators, and other construction equipment to complete the work.
- Crews will take steps to reduce disturbances as needed, including:
 - Noise monitoring to ensure we operate within permitted noise limits.
 - Water trucks to minimize dust pollution.
 - Lights pointed towards the corridor and away from homes during night work.
 - No idling of non-essential equipment.

HOURS OF WORK

- Construction will run from February 9, 2025, until March 16, 2026.
- Work is expected to occur primarily during daytime hours. Night and weekend work may occur as needed.
- Daytime work hours will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Night work hours are from 5 p.m. to 7 a.m., if required.
- Work may be intermittent or continuous, but when active, will follow the hours above.

LOCATION OF WORK

- All work will occur on the east side of the rail corridor behind a Continuous Work Zone (see Figure 1).

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment are expected within the immediate work area and on Union and Townsley streets.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.

TRANSIT IMPACTS

- There are no impacts on GO Transit service.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrians will not be impacted during this work.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Metrolinx has a dedicated community engagement team that works with residents and businesses in the Toronto West area.
