


Geotechnical Investigative Work near Little York Road

Starting February 23, 2026, for approximately 4 weeks

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion project, field crews will carry out utility investigation work overnight to assess ground conditions near the Lakeshore East rail corridor and Danforth station. This due diligence and investigative work will support future track and infrastructure updates. For safety reasons, work will take place overnight when trains are not in service.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

- Crews will use a hydro-vac truck and hand tools to carefully dig small test pits—typically 1–2 metres deep and up to 18 inches wide—to locate and expose underground utilities or watermains.
- This process involves drilling through surfaces to check for potential conflicts.
- Once utilities are confirmed, the pits are backfilled and compacted to restore the area.

DATES AND HOURS OF WORK

- Work begins on February 23 and will last for approximately 4 weeks.
- Working hours will be Monday-Friday: 10 p.m. – 5 a.m.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Nearby properties can expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting around work areas.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - The work area will be safely secured.
 - White noise back up alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
- Please note that work could be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS

- There are no expected impacts to motorists, pedestrians, or transit.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.
