


Subsurface Utilities Investigative Work on Thickson Road

February 16 to March 13, 2026; 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you will not need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As part of the investigative work for the GO Expansion program, crews will be performing subsurface utility engineering (SUE) for utility investigations along Thickson Road between Victoria Street East and Tricont Avenue. This work will take place during daytime hours and require temporary lane closures as highlighted on the map.

Crews will use a hydro-vac truck and hand tools to carefully dig small test pits—typically 1–2 metres deep and up to 18 inches wide—to locate and expose underground utilities or water mains. This process involves drilling through surfaces to check for potential conflicts. Once utilities are confirmed, the pits are filled and compacted to restore the area. Temporary lane reductions will be needed to keep workers and commuters safe during the work, and two-way traffic will be maintained throughout.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Businesses can expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting around work areas.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - The work area will be safely secured.
 - White noise back up alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
- Please note that work could be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

WORK HOURS

- Working hours will be Monday-Friday:
8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- A temporary lane reduction is required to complete this work safely. A single lane for both directions will remain open during this work.
- Motorists can expect to be rerouted around delineated work areas by a traffic control person.
- No additional impacts to motorists, pedestrians, or transit are expected.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- There are no impacts to local transit provision.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There are no impacts to pedestrian sidewalks or crosswalks.
