


# Sound wall installation at Eglinton Avenue West near Kipling Avenue

**Scheduled start and expected completion:** March 2026

**Construction hours:** 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., weekend work may be required

## What is happening?

- Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be installing additional sound walls on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West near Kipling Avenue.
- This work is part of the station box construction on Eglinton Avenue West. A station box is an underground box-like structure that forms the main body of a transit station.
- Sound walls are post and panel structures that are strategically built to dampen and reduce noise from construction. The sound walls will be in place for the duration of construction.
- The sound walls will be approximately five metres tall and are made from pre-cast concrete for sound dampening.



## Pedestrian impacts

- The multi-use pathway on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West will be temporarily closed for the duration of this work.
- The sidewalk will remain open. Cyclists must dismount when accessing the sidewalk.
- Signage will be provided for pedestrians and cyclists during construction.

## Tree pruning and removals

- To accommodate sound wall construction, crews will be pruning and removing selected trees on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West.
- All tree removals and pruning in this area are subject to permit approval from the City of Toronto.
- Metrolinx will plant more trees than we remove.
- Tree removals will occur outside of bird breeding and nesting periods.
- Metrolinx is working closely with the City of Toronto and Toronto Region Conservation Authority to plant new trees as early as we can. Learn more about our tree planting program at [metrolinx.com/vegetation](http://metrolinx.com/vegetation).

## What to expect

- Residents can expect to see construction lighting and hear noise from construction equipment, compactors, drills, excavators and dump trucks.
- Mitigations are being put in place to reduce dust, including the use of water sprayers and biodegradable dust suppressants.
- The information provided is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change.

## About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of Line 5 Eglinton will run 9.2 kilometres from the Mount Dennis Station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
