


McCowan Road impacts and extended work hours north of Triton Road/Bushby Drive

Schedule: Mid-February to end of March 2026

Hours of Work: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. weekdays, and possibility of weekday overnight or Saturday daytime (7:00 a.m. to 5:00 pm) work.

Note: Dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.



What is Happening

- As part of Scarborough Subway Extension construction, crews are continuing to conduct support of excavation (SOE) within the Scarborough Centre station construction site work zone. This will extend into the northbound curb lane just north of Progress Avenue, necessitating its temporary closure.
- SOE is a ground reinforcement activity that creates a retaining structure and groundwater barrier, fortifying the ground in preparation for construction of the Scarborough Centre subway station.

What to Expect

- The lane closure will take place starting mid-February for approximately seven weeks.
- Lane closures will be in place 24 hours a day. Work within the work zones will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. weekdays, with the possibility of work on weekdays overnight or on Saturdays between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Pedestrian, driver, and worker safety will be ensured with the use of appropriate signage, traffic flaggers and/or paid duty officers, and barriers or fencing to define lanes, walkways and work areas.
- Sidewalk and pedestrian access adjacent to work zones will be maintained as will access to TTC bus stops.
- As a result of the ground reinforcement activities, there will be prolonged noise and vibration. Environmental monitors are in place to track noise, vibration and dust levels, and will alert the team should additional mitigation be needed.

About the Project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
