

Simcoe Street Bridge Work: Water Interruption on Simcoe Street and Hall Street

Monday, February 23, 2026 11:00 PM to Tuesday, February 24, 2026 7:00 AM

Alternative Date: Tuesday, February 24, 2026 11:00 PM to Wednesday, February 25, 2026 7:00 AM

What do you need to know?

Metrolinx, in cooperation with the Region of Durham, will be performing a water shutdown to facilitate utility work on the Simcoe Street Bridge. During the above noted period, water service will not be available and will be reinstated upon completion of the work. Bowmanville Construction Partners (BCP) will be performing the utility work on the bridge.

Water Shut-off Details

The properties along the roads shown in Figure 1 will be affected by the water shut-off from

February 23, 2026 11:00 PM to

February 24, 2026 7:00 AM.

If unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather occur, the alternate water shut-off will be rescheduled to February 24, 2026 11:00 PM to February 25, 2026 7:00 AM.

The water shut-off may be longer or shorter than expected and may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

What To Expect

- You are encouraged to store sufficient water for drinking, cooking, and sanitation needs before the shutdown.
- Avoid using appliances such as dishwashers or washing machines, and other appliances that require water during the interruption.
- Residents should expect some noise, vibration, and dust due to construction activities.

After Water Service is Restored

You may notice temporary discoloration in your water. To clear any sediment:

- Turn on the cold water tap only.
- Let it run for approximately five minutes.
- This will flush out any sediment and prevent it from entering your hot water system.
