


Update: Road Closure for Overnight Electrical Pole Installations on Hurontario Street Between John Street and Fairview Road

February 26 at 7 p.m. to February 27, 2026 at 5 a.m.



What You Need to Know

Crews will be installing electrical (Alectra) poles along the east side of Hurontario Street between the CP rail bridge and Fairview Road. This work is scheduled to begin February 26, 2026, at 7 p.m. and will continue until February 27, 2026, at 5 a.m. During this work, northbound traffic will be prohibited on Hurontario Street from John Street to Fairview Road. Detours are available via Hillcrest Avenue, Confederation Parkway and Central Parkway. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained during this work.

Pedestrian crossings will be impacted during this night, including sidewalk closures along the east side of Hurontario Street. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

Transit services and bus stops will be impacted by these construction works, including detours to MiWay routes 2, 53 and 103 and GO bus route 21. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates and www.gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- Overnight work is scheduled for February 26, 2026, starting at 7 p.m. and will finish by 5 a.m. on February 27, 2026.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Northbound traffic will be prohibited on Hurontario Street between John Street and Fairview Road.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained during this work.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Visit MiWay.ca and gotransit.com for updates on your bus route, including detours of MiWay routes 2, 53 and 103 and GO bus route 21.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access along the east side of Hurontario will be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require private property access for this work.
